REGISTRATION AND TITLING

- Registration Operations Statewide – Similar to DMV but for mobilehomes, manufactured homes, commercial modular, and floating homes
- Technical Assistance
- Support Services for the Division (call center, cashiering, mail, shipping receiving, building services, etc.)



- Laws & Regulations
- Certify and Oversee Inspectors and Plan Reviewers
- Conduct Monitoring Audits (worldwide)

- Technical Assistance

RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

• Standards: California Health and Safety Code, sections 18027.3 and 18010; January 1, 1999 – January 13, 2005, ANSI A119.2; On or after January 13, 2005, NFPA 1192. Units must have a complying label.

- Design and construction, Authority Having Appropriate Jurisdiction.
- Alterations or conversions, None.
- Use in HCD-Parks, HCD.
- Installations outside of parks, City and/or County (exception: inside of parks when the LEA).









RECREATIONAL VEHICLE – PARK TRAILERS (A.K.A. PARK MODELS)

• **Standards:** California Health and Safety Code, sections 18027.3 and 18009.3; On or after January 1, 1999, ANSI A119.5. Requires a transportation permit. Units must have a complying label.

- Design and construction, Authority Having Appropriate Jurisdiction.
- Alterations or conversions, None.
- Use in HCD-Parks, HCD.
- Installations outside of parks, City and/or County (exception: inside of parks when the LEA).









CAMPING CABINS

• Standards: California Health and Safety Code, sections 18862.5 and 18871.11; title 25, CCR, section 2327. Allowed only in an SOP by camping party. 400 sq ft. or less, no plumbing. Relocatable hard sided shelter. On or after January 1, 1999, ANSI A119.5. Requires a transportation permit. No label.

- Design and construction, HCD.
- Alterations or conversions, HCD.
- Installations outside of parks, Prohibited.





MOBILEHOMES

• **Standards:** HCD Laws and Regulations; Ref. California Health and Safety Code, section 18025; title 25 of the California Code of Regulations, article 1.2 and section 4050.



- Design and construction, HCD.
- Alterations or conversions, HCD.
- Installations in HCD-Parks, HCD.
- Installations outside of parks, City/Counity (exception: inside of parks when the LEA).













MANUFACTURED HOMES

• Standards For New Units – Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, part 3280. Design and construction under U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) jurisdiction before leaving the manufacturing facility; on the destination site, HCD, title 25 of the California Code of Regulations, section 4050 (minor exception).

- Design and construction, HUD.
- Alterations or conversions, HCD.
- Installations in HCD-Parks, HCD.
- Installations outside of parks, City/County (exception: inside of parks when the LEA).











FACTORY-BUILT HOUSING (MODULAR)

• Standards For New Units – HCD Laws and Regulations; Ref. California Health and Safety Code, section 19960 et seq.; title 25 of the California Code of Regulations, section 3070; by reference the applicable portions of the California Building Standards Code, title 24.

- Design, construction, and factory work, HCD.
- Alterations or conversion onsite, City/County.
- Installations in HCD-Parks, HCD.
- Installations outside of parks, City/County (exception: inside of parks when the LEA).









SITE-BUILT CALIFORNIA BUILDING STANDARDS CODE

COMPLIANT - ADU

• Standards For New Units – one- and two-family dwelling units, and townhouse. HCD Laws and Regulations; Ref. California Health and Safety Code, section 17922; the applicable portions of the California Building Standards Code, title 24, and local city/county amendments.

- Design and construction, HCD/model codes; Local amendments.
- Alterations or conversions, City/County.
- Construction on private property, City/County.
