## **Tuition and Payments**

Tuition is all-inclusive – In addition to a reserved time slot for weekly classes, tuition includes all required piano music and books, worksheets and practice materials as needed throughout the term. There are no additional fees for studio recitals. Students are responsible for RCM exam fees if required and any entry fees to local music festivals or other events.

### **Group Class Tuition (60 minutes)**

Multiple payment schedules are available to accommodate each family's needs and budgets.

\$119 x 10 instalments (due on the 1st of each month Sept. – June)

\$395 x 3 instalments (due Sept. 1, Dec. 1 and Mar. 1

\$1,185 x 1 instalment (due Sept. 1)

<u>Late Fees</u>: A \$15 fee will be charged on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the month, and an additional \$20 fee will be applied on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. Lessons will be suspended after the 15<sup>th</sup> day of any month a tuition payment remains outstanding.

# Piano Studio Policies (Group Classes)

### Student absences

Due to the nature of group classes and the set schedule, no credits can be given for student absences.

#### **Teacher Absences**

In rare cases where cancellation is necessary by the teacher, every effort will be made to schedule a make-up class at a mutually convenient time for the students enrolled in the class and the teacher. If a make-up class is not possible, a credit will be given to the students.

#### Discontinuation

The first 16 weeks of classes are non-refundable, and no credits can be issued for the initial 16 weeks. If a student must discontinue lessons before the end of the term (June 9, 2023), a requirement of 30 days' notice will apply. The next four classes following the notification will remain as being paid for by the student, and the student is encouraged to attend those classes if possible. A pro-rating will be calculated at a rate of 50% of any remaining weeks after the initial 16 weeks of classes or 30 days' notice, whichever is later, to determine any balance due or owed.

### Media Release

Photos, videos, and audio recordings of students during lessons and performances may be posted online and/or used for promotional or instructional purposes. Identifying information will be limited to first names only. Adult students, and parents wishing to exempt their children from any published media may do so by providing a written exclusion request.
