## Private Piano Lessons Registration

Term dates: **September 12, 2022 – June 12, 2023**

### **The studio will be closed on the following dates:**

December 23 – January 6 inclusive (2 weeks)

March 13 - 24 inclusive (2 weeks)

**Monday Holidays:** October 10, February 20 and May 22

***Please note:*** Students with **Monday time slots** will have their last spring lesson on **June 12**, the last day of the term

### **Tuition Rates and Payments:**

**Tuition is all-inclusive** – In addition to a reserved time slot for weekly lessons, tuition includes all required piano music and books, worksheets and practice materials as needed throughout the term. There are no additional fees for studio recitals. Students are responsible for RCM exam fees if required and any entry fees to local music festivals or other events.

Multiple payment schedules are available to accommodate each family's needs and budgets.

- 1 installment due Sept. 1
- 3 installments due Sept. 1, Dec. 1 and Mar. 1
- 10 installments due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month from Sept. – June

**Late Fees:** A \$15 fee will be charged on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the month, and an additional \$20 fee will be applied on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. Lessons will be suspended after the 15<sup>th</sup> day of any month a tuition payment remains outstanding.

### **Student Absences and Make-Up Lessons:**

- **Inclement Weather, Illness and Unavoidable Conflicts:** If weather conditions at lesson time are unsafe to drive in, or a student is unable to attend their lesson due to illness or unavoidable conflict, the student should attend their lesson over video if possible, if the student is well enough. (See also **Make-up Lessons** below.)
- **School Absences:** Students should remain at home if they did not attend school on their lesson day due to illness and should attend their lesson over video (if able and well enough).
- **Make-up Lessons:** If a student must cancel a lesson, access to the online student portal allows students to cancel a lesson which issues a make-up credit which they can use to register for future open time slots on the studio calendar. Availability for make-up lessons is limited to open time slots (if any) and cancellations during regular studio hours and are not guaranteed to be possible. No credits can be given for student absences. All make-up lessons must be requested and completed before the end of the term (June 12, 2023) and cannot be carried over into the summer term.

**Teacher absences:** In rare cases where cancellation is necessary by the teacher, every effort will be made to schedule a make-up lesson at a mutually convenient time. If a make-up lesson is not possible, a credit will be applied to the student's account.

**Discontinuation:** If a student must discontinue lessons before the end of the term, a requirement of one month's notice will apply. The next 4 lessons following the notification will remain as being paid for by the student, and the student is encouraged to attend those lessons if possible. A pro-rating will be calculated to determine any balance due or owed.

**Media Release:** Photos, videos, and audio recordings of students during lessons and performances may be used for promotional or instructional purposes online. Identifying information will be limited to first names only. Parents wishing to exempt their students from any published media may do so by providing a written exclusion request.
