

Whitewater Venue Rules and Reminders

- Venue deposits are non-refundable.
- Guests may arrive 30 minutes before ceremony time.
- All weddings/events must have insurance.
- The consumption of alcohol by minors is strictly prohibited. At any time, if the venue staff or licensed bartenders deems alcohol consumption to be excessive, the staff has the authority to close down all alcohol service and/or evict inebriated guests from the premises. Any intoxicated guests are the responsibility of the reserving party.
- No driving/parking on the grass except for designated parking lots/areas.
- Venue rental times include setup and breakdown time.
- All Events must end by 10:00 pm to comply with the county sound ordinances and in order to allow for clean-up and closure of the site by 11:00 pm
- Dogs on leashes may be part of your ceremony with prior arrangements.
- Birdseed or dried wildflowers are great please no fake flowers and/or other non-biodegradable materials may not be spread on the grass in the reception or ceremony locations.
- The Client is responsible for all guests and the wedding party attending the event. Any damage or loss resulting from the event attendees will be billed to the reserving party.
- The booking party cannot hold Whitewater Weddings, LLC responsible for failure to provide the basic facilities and services due to emergencies, catastrophes, excessive weather, or interruptions of public utilities. Whitewater Weddings LLC. will allow you to reschedule if possible. If an Act of God were to occur preventing the event from taking place as scheduled, Whitewater Weddings LLC will allow for the event to be rescheduled, pending availability, with no penalty. Last-minute cancellations of outdoor sites due to inclement weather will not be considered for refunds. Tents are allowed at the venue, and small tents are provided.
- Courtesy Protocol: Whitewater Weddings LLC reserves the right to request any person or group of people acting unruly and contrary to rental regulations to leave the premises. Assistance from law enforcement agencies may be acquired if this request is not met immediately.
- The client must designate an on-site representative who will be in contact with the venue as needed.
- All decorations must be placed and removed without leaving damage. Be kind and leave the property as you found it.
- All trash must be picked up and removed from the venue after your event. If trash is left it is a \$250 removal fee.
- No sparklers, open flames, or candles of any kind are permitted without explicit approval by the venue.
- Guest must stay within the venue area, we are a working organic farm, and need guests to respect the boundaries.
