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Purchase Agreement & Health Guarantee

This agreement hereinafter known as "Agreement" is between KBz Dachshunds (known as breeder/seller) and _____ (Buyer Name). After reviewing and signing this Agreement, it becomes legally binding. Breeder/Seller agrees to the following:

- Puppy/Canine has been seen by a licensed veterinarian and is in good health and no issues were found as of date of transfer.
- Puppy/Canine has been dewormed at a schedule of 2,4,6 & 8 weeks.
- Puppy/Canine has had vaccinations appropriate for age and Breeder/Seller has provided record of such to Buyer.
- Puppy/Canine will come with a microchip which is included in the total purchase price.
- Puppy/Canine is being sent home with CKC application for buyer to submit.
- Puppy/Canine is being sold as a **PET/COMPANION ONLY** with Limited CKC registration. Seller has registered the entire litter and gives application for Puppy/Canine upon pickup to Buyer.
 - Buyer is responsible to complete and send in to CKC (Continental Kennel Club) for the registration in their name in their own time.
- Pet/companion only limited CKC requires buyer to spay/neuter said puppy/canine upon their 1-year (or sooner) Birthday unless otherwise recommended by their licensed Veterinarian. In this case, said recommendation must be documented and signed by buyers licensed Veterinarian and forwarded to the breeder/seller no less than 30 days PRIOR to deadline to keep in compliance with this Agreement. Proof of Spay/Neuter must be sent to Breeder/Seller no more than 7 days after deadline unless otherwise stated above with Breeder/Seller knowledge and compliance.
 - Failure to provide documentation of Veterinarian recommendation different than what is required in this Agreement, or failure to provide documentation of Spay/Neuter by the deadline specified above will result in violation of this Agreement. _____(Buyer Initials)
 - Violation of Agreement will result in
 - KBz Dachshunds regaining possession of Puppy/Canine in accordance with this Agreement. Any costs pertaining to this process including but not limited to: Filing Fees, Serving Costs, Travel expenses, Veterinarian bills for Puppy/Canine upon retrieval to ensure he/she is free of illnesses that may be passed on to other animals around KBz Dachshunds, Fleas, Worms, etc.. will be the responsibility of the buyer.

Buyer Agrees to the following.

- Buyer will bring Puppy/Canine to Licensed Veterinarian as stated, and on a regular basis for routine exams and preventative treatments.
- Buyer agrees to take care of Puppy/Canine for its lifetime.
Buyer agrees this Puppy/Canine cannot be given/sold/traded/bartered with any third party without Breeder/Sellers written consent.
- Buyer understands that any health conditions as a result to weight, parasites, or anything outside of the Health Guarantee will NOT be refunded, whatsoever. It is extremely important to keep your puppy/canine from jumping, overeating, over excreting, or not getting enough exercise.
- If for ANY reason, buyer is unable to keep Puppy/Canine, they will contact Breeder/Seller immediately and breeder/seller will take possession of puppy/canine at no cost to breeder/seller and no refund will be given at time of surrender. If Breeder rehomes said puppy/canine and a rehoming fee is paid, breeder/seller will refund buyer that amount minus \$50.00 per week for boarding fees and any/all Veterinarian bills that have occurred while puppy/canine has been in breeder/sellers care to ensure they are in good health for rehoming to new buyer. Refund must not exceed total value of puppy/canine. _____ (Buyer Initials)
- Buyer will keep the Breeder/Seller informed of any address or phone number changes (Breeder/Seller will do the same) _____ (Buyer Initials)
- This Puppy/Canine will not be used for breeding under any circumstances. If this occurs, even if by accident, all warranties will be null and void in this agreement. Please read continuance below.
 - To follow this, for every offspring of this Puppy/Canine that was bred against this Agreement, buyer will pay Seller/Breeder (KB

Miniature Dachshunds) a total of \$1000.00 **per** offspring, and Seller/Breeder can take possession of canine as part of this Agreement with Limited CKC registration and requirement to spay/neuter. _____(Buyer Initials)

- Buyer must send Breeder/Seller pictures of puppy/Canine every 9-12months for the duration of its life to ensure the the Puppy/Canine is still being cared for as buyer agrees in this Agreement. _____(Buyer Initials)
- Buyer agrees that Breeder/Seller has offered and/or provided a copy of Maine's Title 7, Chapter 745
- If final payment is made at pick up, it must be made in cash. Personal checks or credit card payments will **NOT** be accepted. There are absolutely no exceptions to this.

Health Guarantee

(Returns, Refunds, Exchanges, etc)

The Breeder/Seller (known as) KBz Miniature Dachshunds hereby states that Puppy/Canine Referred to above is found to be in good health with no health conditions found during Veterinarian Examination on _____. Date of transfer is specifically the date of _____in which is the pick-up date.

At KBz Dachshunds, we pride ourselves with the care and love of all the babies and fur families we serve. The wellbeing of puppy/canine is of course priority above all. If you have not previously owned a dachshund, you should do your research and become familiar with the breed before bringing your puppy/canine home. KBz Dachshunds HIGHLY recommends a strict healthy diet to maintain an idle weight and to limit any risks of health problems associated to weight. Lack of exercise, excessive jumping or over exercising

before full grown could lead to serious problems and that's something we want to have prevented.

Buyer understands that the color, size, coat etc. is only an estimate based on the size of parents and/or previous litters, etc. and that there is NO guarantee as to size, color, coat, or temperament of puppy/canine. Dachshunds are prone to back issues, especially if they become overweight. Please, refrain from free feeding. We provide a list of our recommended foods while in puppy stage and adult stage, if you would like further advice or recommendations, please contact your veterinarian.

State of Health

Short-Term Health Warranty- The puppy/canine:

- was previously examined by a licensed veterinarian and was found to be in good health at that time and
- has had the immunizations enumerated in the health records provided to Buyer. Buyer, at its own expense, must have the puppy/dog examined by a licensed veterinarian within 10 days (or in accordance with immunizations.) If, within the Examination Period, a licensed veterinarian finds the puppy/canine to be unhealthy or unfit for sale, the puppy/canine may be returned to Breeder for a full refund of the Purchase Price. The veterinarian must provide a written statement deeming the puppy/canine "unfit for purchase", which must be sent to Breeder within 48 hours of the veterinary examination. The foregoing guarantee expressly excludes the following:

- any health issues caused by Buyer's ill-treatment, abuse, or neglect.
- any issues caused from puppy/canine jumping, digestion of foods or items they should not be consuming, or otherwise anything that could be prevented by the buyer.
- any health issues that result from the puppy/dog's transportation from Breeder to Buyer and
- all minor illnesses and health issues, including upper respiratory infections, allergic reactions, stress colitis/diarrhea, internal or external parasites or contagious viruses (including canine parvovirus), UTIs, vaginitis or umbilical hernias.
