



Welcome to Prom Central Caravan Park

Park Rules and Conditions:

- **Alcohol** – May be consumed responsibly and in moderation by adults on your sites or in BBQ area.
- **Amenities** – Please leave all facilities as you would like them and report any damage or malfunction to Office so it can be attended to promptly. Children must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult at all times. Please observe “closed for cleaning” signs.
- **Behaviour** – All guests have the right to the peaceful and quiet enjoyment of their site. Excessive noise, unruly behaviour, drunkenness or bad language is not tolerated in our Park. Quiet Time: 10pm – 7am.
- **Bikes, Scooters, Skateboards and Rollerblades** – To be ridden at walking pace only and helmets must be worn at all times. No riding after dark. Children 12 years and under to be supervised at all times when riding in the Park. For safety reasons battery or powered scooters or motorized kid carts are not to be used within the Park.
- **Boom Gate** – (Planned)The boom gate is erected for the safety and security of all guests. Please use your boom gate key for entry. When you exit, the boom gate with lift automatically. Please do not tail through the gate after another vehicle. Failure to comply with this may result in damage to your car or our boom gate.
- **CHECK-OUT** – Check-out is 10am. Late check-out may be arranged before 10am, subject to availability, a fee may be incurred.
- **Clothes Line** – The Clothes Line is located by the Laundry and Amenity block. Please do not erect makeshift lines.
- **Dump Point** – Please dispose of black water at the dump point. **LIQUIDS ONLY !** The Shire Dump Point is located at BP Service station.
- **Extending your stay** – If extending, please contact the Office prior to your check out day.
- **Fires** – Solid fuel fires including heat beads are not permitted at any time in the park area without permission. Portable gas and electric BBQ’s and cook tops are permitted, however they are not to be used on days of total fire ban.
- **Garbage and Recycling** – Bins are located throughout the Park for disposal of garbage and recyclable material. **Green** lid bins are for garbage and **Yellow** lid bins are for recycling. Do NOT bag up recyclables. Please assist us by wrapping up non recyclable garbage prior to disposal.
- **Generators** – The use of generators is not permitted.
- **Liability** – Park Operators & Management are not liable to guests or third parties of any personal injury, loss or damage. The Principal occupant must be over 18 and is responsible for their children’s and visitor’s actions. Guest must ensure that property and valuables are stored securely at all times.
- **Messages/Mail** – Only emergency messages will be delivered to your site. All other messages and mail is held at the Park Office for your collection.
- **Minors** – Guests under 18 years of age must be under parental supervision at all times. After 9pm, children must confine social activities to a site under direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian.
- **Pets** - At Managers discretion of each stay. Dogs to be kept on a leash at all times and Owners must clean up after them. Dogs are not to be in the Park cabins, Amenities or Camp Kitchen. Visitors are not permitted to bring pets in the Park.

- **Refunds** – We do not give refunds for early departures, or if you simply change your mind or circumstances, or if you have selected the wrong accommodation for you.
- **Site Occupancy** – Sites and Accommodation are to be left in a clean and tidy manner or a cleaning fee will apply. No Mechanical repairs to be carried out within the Park.
- **Smoking / Smoke Alarm** – No smoking in any Buildings, Cabins or Communal area. Guests should ensure that they have a working smoke alarm.
- **Speed Limit** – Strictly 5 km per hour within Park boundaries.
- **Vehicle Parking** – Provision is made for one vehicle per site only and ensure your vehicle doesn’t encroach on any part of the roadway or site. Do not park or drive on other sites. Additional and visitors vehicles can be parked in the visitor’s car park or outside the Park.
- **Water Usage** – Water restrictions apply. Use water conservatively. No vehicle or caravan washing is permitted in the Park.
- **Visitors** – All visitors must register at the Office. You are welcome to have visitors from 8am to 9.30pm.

Park Management reserves the right:

To remove, without notice, any person(s) who contravene these and other park regulations and /or behave in an offensive or disorderly manner that affects the well-being of the Park and its Users. This may result in charges to the site user. Park Management takes no responsibility, for any loss or damage to property or person
