Painting Supplies

Cheap Joe's White Synthetic Short Handle Watercolor Brushes (Flat 1/2" and 1" and Rounds 4, 8 and 12)

1" bristle brush sold at Cheap Joe's as a "Skipper". Sometimes I use a 1 1/2" and

2" Skipper"brushes.

Round sable brushes by Legend sizes #8, #10, #16

Palette: I use a Skip Lawrence palette. I prefer a palette without deep wells.

Paper: I tape Kilimanjaro or Arches (300lb or 140lb) cold-press paper to a piece of masonite with a white plastic surface ideally 1 inch larger around than the paper.

If you're using an arches or kilimanjaro "block", this is how you remove a page.

4B pencil to sketch and kneaded eraser:

Assortment of scraping tools like palette knives, pocket knives, and even a bone folder I bought from Michaels, Amazon or a stationary store.

Masking Tape 1/2" or better yet 1/4" This is an essential!

A few containers for water (I use Fage Yougart containers)

Paper towels to clean up messes.

An apron to protect your clothes
