Species Grown; Grows a wide range of locally indigenous species specific to the Bellarine Peninsula only, see plant list on website.

Opening Hours; By appointment only.

Seed Source; All seed is locally collected by nursery volunteers.

Capacity; Currently grow approx. 50,000- 60,000 plants per year.

Order date; For larger orders at least 6 months (sometimes more- dependant on species) lead time is required.

Unit Cost; Forestry tubes; \$2.28, Hiko cell trays \$1.14 (for hikos -minimum purchase of 1 tray -40 plants)

Comments: Trees and shrubs are grown in forestry tubes, grass species are grown in hiko cell trays. A comprehensive plant list is easily accessible via the above website. Please contact the nursery manager for further information on lead in times etc.

Species Grown; the nursery grows a wide range of indigenous species occurring within an approximate distance of 40 km from Ballarat and intends to grow a range of wetland and aquatic species commencing in 2022.

Opening Hours; Every Wednesday between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm.

Seed Source; All locally sourced, mostly volunteer collected seed is used.

Capacity; 25,000 plants approx.

Order date; no set date, earlier orders (Oct- Dec) preferred for larger quantities.

Unit Cost; Nil

Comments; The City of Ballarat Community Nursery is operated by volunteers and supplies indigenous plants to the City of Ballarat, local Landcare groups, local schools, environmental and 'friends' groups within the City of Ballarat local government area. Please contact the council or other relevant land manager before commencing any planting on public land.

Species Grown; the nursery grows an extensive range of locally indigenous plants. A stock availability list is posted on their website monthly.

Opening Hours; 7.30 am to 5.00 pm Monday to Friday

Seed Source; Indigenous species are sourced from locally obtained seed.

Capacity; A large scale commercial nursery, Eco Dynamics has the capacity to supply any quantity of plants given suitable notice.

Order date; A week notice is preferred for collection of small orders, for larger orders or those being grown to order at least several months' notice is usually required, dependant on the time of the year.

Unit Costs; prices vary dependant on species and quantity and start from approx. \$1.00 per unit, plants are available in 'half tube' and hiko formats.

Comments; Minimum order of approx. 50 plants.

Species Grown; this nursery grows a very wide range of local plant species indigenous to the Victorian volcanic plains from approx. Footscray in the east to the west as far as Geelong and Balliang. A comprehensive plant list is posted on their Facebook page.

Seed Source: All seed is locally sourced.

Opening Hours; Mon- Sat 11am–4pm, Sunday 12am–4pm

Capacity; The nursery has the ability to supply quite large orders as long as suitable notification is given and is dependent on the time of the year.

Order date. For 'to grow' orders required for the autumn/winter planting season the cut-off date is mid January.

Comments; Plants are available in forestry tubes and cell trays, hiko trays are not available.

Species Grown; Moorabool Landcare Network Indigenous Nursery grows a wide range of plants indigenous to the Rowsley Valley and Brisbane Ranges.

Opening Hours; By appointment only.

Seed Source; Locally sourced seed, with some focus on Brisbane Ranges provenances as well as the Rowsley Valley and seed supplied by Seeding Victoria.

Capacity; Current production is 55,000 plants.

Order date; Preferred order date is 1st December for supply the following year and earlier for winter germinants such as Bursaria. Orders after that date are dependent on stock availability.

Unit Costs; Forestry Tubes \$1.45, Hiko cell trays \$1.20.

Comments; A recently re-established nursery, assisted by volunteers.

Species Grown; the nursery grows an extensive range of locally indigenous plants as well as shelterbelt and other native species.

Opening Hours; Wed-Thurs 8.00 am – 4.00 pm, Friday 8.00 am – 1.30 pm

Seed Source; Oz Trees grow a wide range of indigenous and non-indigenous plants, if required they can stipulate seed provenances with suppliers to ensure local seed is used.

Capacity; A large scale commercial nursery, Oz Trees has the capacity to supply any quantity of plants given suitable notice.

Order date; for plants to be grown to order for planting the following year the cut-off time is the end of August/early September. For plants already in stock, as early as possible orders are preferred.

Unit Cost; for larger Landcare orders the cost per unit is \$0.96 for hikos and 5 cm tubes. For smaller retail orders approx. starting price is \$1.20.

Comments; This nursery supplies plants in 5 cm half forestry tubes or hiko cell trays and also has an experienced and knowledgeable planting crew able to undertake large scale reveg. plantings given sufficient notice.

Species Grown; Western Plains Flora grows a very diverse range of species indigenous to the areas just to the west of Melbourne

Opening Hours; Open Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm, Saturday 9am to 1pm (not public holidays)

Seed Source; All seed is locally sourced.

Capacity; A large commercial nursery focussing only on indigenous plants, with suitable ordering time frames, substantial orders can be supplied.

Order date; **the** preferred date for orders to be submitted by is at the latest the end of November for supply the following planting season.

Unit Costs; Western Plains Flora generally supplies plants in forestry tubes or cells. Prices are varied and dependant on species, format and difficulty or otherwise of propagation. Cell prices begin approx. \$1.00, with forestry tubes at approx. \$1.60 per unit. Please contact the nursery for further information.

Comments; Ian Taylor and staff have an excellent knowledge of the local flora and plants are invariably of good quality.

In addition to the listed nurseries, there are a no. of others some distance away who may be able to assist with plant supply if the above do not have suitable plants, though would be considered outside of the usual supply area in most cases.
