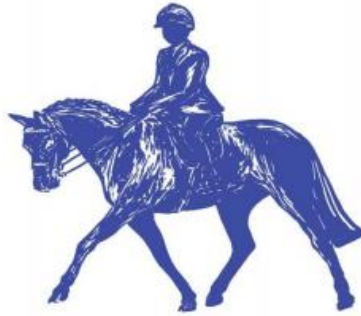

- Please provide your email address, mobile number & **all** vehicle registrations that will be attending the show. If we do not have the information, they will not be allowed to enter the event.
- DO NOT arrive sooner than 1 hour before your class.
- ARRIVE, COMPETE, LEAVE.
- Except for the RIHS qualifying classes, you do not need to be a member of the BSPS.

Correctly secured **British Standard Skull cap/ Riding Hat no's all PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards – Please see Rule 45 in the 2021 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook**, that meet current safety standards must be worn by riders at all times when mounted. **Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes including practice ring at B.S.P.S. Affiliated shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes).** Paramedics will be in attendance. BSPS "This show is affiliated the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

Any pony taking part in classes judged under BSPS rules will be liable to dope testing.

RIHS QUALIFIERS

This show is a qualifier for the 2021 RIHS. Competitors qualifying at this show for the Longines Royal International Horse Show must submit their entries online within 48 hours of qualifying at <http://www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-and-results/longines-fei-jumping-nations-cup-of-great-britain-at-the-royal-international-horse-show/>

The highest placed pony (not already qualified) from the first three ponies in the mini show pony classes, open SP classes, open lead rein hunter type, open SHP classes, open intermediate SR, SH & WH, Anglo & part bred Arab, open NS, open WHP classes, Heritage LR and FR & Ridden, Heritage M&M Pretty Polly Lead Rein & First Ridden classes, Pretty Polly Heritage Ridden Mixed Breeds, Pretty Polly mixed height SP & SHP will qualify.

Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with qualification for RIHS and animals must be registered with the BSPS, except for the Anglo Part Bred Arab classes who must be registered with the AHS.

BSPS QUALIFIERS

This show is a qualifier for the 2021 BSPS Championship show to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in the following classes – Open lead rein and open first ridden, open 128/138/148cm SP, open 122/133/143/153cm SHP, open nursery stakes, open 133,143,153 WHP classes will qualify.

1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the following classes: Open Intermediate SRT, WH, SHT classes, Cradles Stakes will qualify. **MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES.** The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify for the BSPS Championship show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

THE BSPS CLASSIC SERVICES GROUP CHALLENGE

BSPS Rule 454 in the 2021 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook

This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Classic Services Group Challenge. Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any B.S.P.S. affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SRT, SH and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2021 Horse of the Year Show. If a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the Classic Services Group Challenge.

THE BSPS "BINKS FAMILY" CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

The 1st Prize winners in the following classes will qualify for The Binks Family Champion of Champions :- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Ponies, Open WHP, Open SHP, Open LRHT, Open Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP Classes

THE BSPS "THE WHITE COMPANY" MINI WHP CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

The 1st prize winners in the Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes will qualify for The White Company Mini WHP Champion of Champions.

BSPS BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Blue Riband Pony of the Year. The 1st and 2nd placed ponies in the open lead rein, open first ridden, open 128/138/148cm show pony and open 122/133/143/153cm show hunter pony, open 133/143/153cm WHP, intermediate SRT, SH and WH classes will qualify. Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with Blue Riband Qualification.

BSPS BEST OF THE BEST Best of the Best Area Supreme Championship, the Area champion from each day will compete at the BSPS Summer Championship Show 2021. All ponies/horses competing must be owned, registered and ridden by Area 3A members.

BSPS Desert Orchid WHP Qualifier This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Desert Orchid WHP of the Year

THE B.S.P.S. "BINKS FAMILY" CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

At this show, the 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify for The Binks Family Champion of Champions: - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Ponies, Open WHP, Open SHP, Open LRHT, Open Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP Classes.

THE B.S.P.S. "THE WHITE COMPANY" MINI WHP CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

At this show, the 1st prize winners in the Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes will qualify for The White Company Mini WHP Champion of Champions.

THE 'DONALDSON FAMILY' SUPREME PRETTY POLLY RIDDEN PONY CHAMPIONSHIP The final to be held at the North of England Summer Pony Show. **Kindly sponsored by The Donaldson Family.**

The Pretty Polly Champion will qualify. If the Champion has already qualified then the Reserve Champion will go forward. .

THE 'GRIBBIN FAMILY' SUPREME RIDDEN PONY CHAMPIONSHIP The final to be held at the North of England Summer Pony Show. **Kindly sponsored by The Gribbin Family.**

The SHP Champion will qualify. If the Champion has already qualified then the Reserve Champion will go forward.

THE 'BRYONY GRIBBIN' SUPREME MINI PONY CHAMPIONSHIP The final to be held at the North of England Summer Pony Show. **Kindly sponsored by The Gribbin Family.**

The LR of Hunter Type Winner and Heritage Mini Champion will qualify. If the winner has already qualified then the 2nd prize winner or reserve champion will go forward.

THE 'PLEVIN FAMILY' SUPREME RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND CHAMPIONSHIP. The final to be held at the North of England In Hand and Mountain & Moorland Show. **Kindly sponsored by Simon and Sue Plevin.**

The Champion Open Ridden M & M will qualify. If the Champion has already qualified then the Reserve Champion will go forward.

UKPH (R.I.H.S.) YOUNG RIDERS M&M RIDDEN CLASSES To be judged according to the rules and regulations of UK Ponies and Horses PLEASE NOTE that the Owner, riders MUST be current UK Ponies and Horses Annual/Senior/Junior Riding club members and the ponies currently registered with UK Ponies and Horses before the date of the show in order to compete on these classes. Open to Mountain and Moorlands Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), mare or gelding, 4 yrs old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C & D. The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will receive notification of their qualification for the (R.I.H.S) Young Riders M&M Ridden Final at The (R.I.H.S) Hickstead 2021.

UKPH (R.I.H.S.) AMATEUR RIDERS M&M RIDDEN CLASS To be judged according to the rules and regulations of UK Ponies and Horses PLEASE NOTE that the Owner, riders MUST be current UK Ponies and Horses Annual/Senior/Junior Riding club members and the ponies currently registered with UK Ponies and Horses before the date of the show in order to compete on these classes. Open to Mountain and Moorlands Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), mare or gelding, 4 yrs old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C & D. The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will receive notification of their qualification for the (R.I.H.S) Young Riders M&M Ridden Final at The (R.I.H.S) Hickstead 2021.

Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season: (i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.(ii) Receive remuneration for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or Riding School (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets. (iii) Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt

for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment. (iv) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador or Supported Person, in any showing classes, UK Ponies and Horses or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in any Open classes, UK Ponies and Horses or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working Show Horse and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the previous year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show. The above Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and only ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership. No person included on any affiliated Judging Panel can compete in a UK Ponies and Horses Amateur Class. UK Ponies and Horses feel that this is not entering into the spirit of the competition. On the day when an Exhibit is competing in an Amateur class, Professionals are not allowed to ride or work-in the relevant animal. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse (B) Amateur Owner/Rider. Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur, (the Rider need not be the Owner of the Horse). This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse. (C) Amateur Home Produced. Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

The judges named in this schedule have accepted the invitation to judge, but the committee reserve the right to appoint a substitute for any judge unable to attend. Whilst every effort is made to avoid clashing, competitors must decide which class to compete in if this is unavoidable. **CLASSES WILL NOT BE DELAYED FOR EXHIBITORS WHO HAVE NOT MADE THIS PROVISION.**

Class 1 BSPPS CRADLE STAKES. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

RIHS WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES

Class 2 BSPPS RIHS NURSERY STAKES. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Mini championship: 1st and 2nd prize winners from open cradle & nursery stakes to compete.

Classes 1 & 2 and Mini Championship kindly sponsored by Rosettes for You

Class 3 BSPPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE WHP Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders must jump in the correct height section and be the correct age for the height of animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are in a different height section. Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cms or the intermediate section.

Class 4 BSPPS RIHS OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY. Mare or Gelding 4 years or over not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 5 BSPPS RIHS OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY. Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 6 BSPPS RIHS OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY. Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 7 BSPPS RIHS INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER. Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Championship: 1st and 2nd Prize winners from classes 4-7 to compete.

Class 8 BSPPS MIXED HEIGHT OPEN WHP/INTERMEDIATE WH, Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms.
