

PISTOL RANGE GUIDELINES

- _____ FIREARMS MUST BE UNLOADED, MAGAZINES REMOVED AND ACTIONS OPENED OR CASSED WHEN ENTERING AND EXITING THE PISTOL RANGE. HOLSTERED FIREARMS ARE NOT PERMITTED DURING OPEN SHOOT
- _____ BULLETS MAY ONLY BE LOADED INTO MAGAZINES AT THE LOADING TABLES. FOR REVOLVERS, LOAD CYLINER AT THE LINE
- _____ GUN MUST REMAIN UNLOADED UNTIL THE SHOOTER IS AT THE FIRING LINE. THIS MEANS EMPTY CHAMBER, NO MAGAZINE IN GUN, HAMMER OR STRIKER DOWN.
- _____ ALWAYS WEAR EYE & EAR PROTECTION.
- _____ KEEP FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER UNTIL THE SIGHTS ARE ON THE TARGET AND YOU ARE READY TO SHOOT. NEVER LET THE MUZZLE OF A WEAPON POINT AT ANYTHING YOU ARE NOT WILLING TO DESTROY. ALWAYS BE SURE OF YOUR TARGET & WHAT IS BEYOND IT
- _____ WHEN TAKING A FIREARM TO OR FROM THE FIRING LINE KEEP THE MUZZLE POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION.
- _____ ABSOLUTELY NO HANDLING OF FIREARMS WHEN SHOOTERS ARE DOWN RANGE. WAIT UNTIL THE CURRENT SHOOTER IS DONE THEN LOAD AS NEEDED AND PROCEED TO THE FIREING LINE
- _____ IMMEDIATELY STOP SHOOTING WHEN ANYONE CALLS "CEASE FIRE" OR 'STOP'. IF YOU ARE ON THE FIRING LINE, PUT DOWN YOUR FIREARM, BACK AWAY FROM THE FIRING LINE, AND WAIT FOR THE "ALL CLEAR" SIGNAL.
- _____ DO NOT SHOOT TARGETS THAT EXPLODE, NO TANERAITE IS ALLOWED!
- _____ PISTOL CALIBER COWBOY ACTION RIFFLES ARE ALLOWED. SHOTGUNS ARE ALLOWED FOR COWBOY ACTION SHOOTING, OR ON THE PATTERN BOARD, FOR THIS THEY MUST BE SHOT IN THE SAME DIRECTION AS THE TRAP FIELDS.
- _____ NO HIGH-POWERED/MAGNUM AMMUNITION IS ALLOWED ON THE PISTOL RANGE.
- _____ NO HIGH-POWERED RIFLES ARE ALLOWED ON THE PISTOL RANGE
- _____ CLEAN ALL TRASH YOU PRODUCE. PICK UP YOUR BRASS/TRASH. PLEASE KEEP THE RANGE CLEAN
- _____ PLACE PAPER TARGETS ON THE RUBBER BELT PART OF THE BACKSTOPS.
- _____ REMOVE ALL PAPER TARGETS FROM BACKSTOPS WHEN FINISHED.
- _____ ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES.
- _____ RETURN ALL EQUIPMENT/TARGETS/TABLES TO THE WAY YOU FOUND THEM AND DISPOSE OF ANY BROKEN TARGETS IN THE TRASH.
- _____ STEEL TARGETS MAY BE SHOT AT NO CLOSER THAN 10 YARDS
- _____ STEEL TARGETS WILL BE PRE-SET UP BY THE BOARD AND SHOULD NOT BE MOVED. THEY WILL BE SET UP ROTATED TOWARDS THE WEST AND DOWN TO PREVENT AS MUCH SPLATTER AS POSSIBLE. SOME WILL STILL OCCUR
- _____ IF ANY EQUIPMENT IS DAMAGED, PUT A NOTE ON IT AND SET IT ASIDE IN THE TRAILER AND NOTIFY A RANGE OFFICER.

I UNDERSTAND THAT A VIOLATION OF THESE GUIDELINES WILL RESULT IN THE REQUEST TO LEAVE FOR THE DAY AND A POTENTIAL TO LOSE MY MEMBERSHIP TO THE CLUB.
