Crack the Bar 80-day study schedule

California Bar Exam

Begin by counting 80 days from the bar exam to figure out your start date. If you have any other obligations, plan accordingly and push your start date earlier.

- Take note the last 8 days before the bar exam are earmarked for specific tasks.
- This schedule allows for review of all the subjects 3 times through + a final review.
- The first round of review accounts for all essays from July 2012- February 2021, and all 90-minute performance exams from July 2017-February 2021. All the selected answers and exams are found on the state bar website.
- All essays should be written open book, and MBE should be taken open book until you are comfortable closed book.
- This schedule is just a suggestion intended to ease the stressful question of "what should I do today"
- This schedule allows for flexibility as you can self-assign essays beyond July 2012 or move some essays to review during review rounds 2 and 3 if it becomes overwhelming.
- ➤ If you are starting late, or do not have 80 days to study, this schedule can be condensed as needed, but be sure to earmark at least 5 days before the exam for final review.
- ➤ It is suggested to review at least 10 Performance exams before you take the bar.
- It is suggested to stick to the MBE schedule and to do no less than 50 MBE a day. Using the Strategies and Tactics book by Emmanuel is not required, but recommended, in addition to any other MBE source.
- ➤ If you struggle on the MBE, you need to do more. It is 50% of your grade and you have to have the stamina to do 200 in one day, so do not underprepare by doing under 50 a day.

I hope this schedule helps you, it may look intimidating, but it is 100% doable, especially if you start early. Keep in mind these are just suggestions, if you feel it will not work for you, do what is best for you. <u>If you stay on track, you will have reviewed more than 200 essays and over 4000 mbes before the bar exam.</u>

- > *"S&T" refers to Strategies and Tactics by Emmanuel. Complete the entire book, then do it again.
- > *Supplement S&T with some other MBE source such as Adaptibar, Uworld, Barmax, or any other prep books. <u>EMAIL ME FOR DISCOUNT CODES.</u>
- *"Mixed MBE" means to mix the subjects e.g. 10/subject, if it does not say mixed, then do the assigned subject only.

Days 73-77 are semi-optional, meaning, you can choose to review/practice whatever you want in those days. However, it is highly recommended that if you have been following this schedule, that you spend the last 3 days reviewing all the laws only. **As always, if you feel you NEED to review essays and MBE, then do what feels right to you.** You have had plenty of practice on essays and MBE if you stayed on schedule, it is time to make sure you do a full and thorough final review all your laws one last time before the exam.
