North Island Transport Package:

Carr & Haslam will be transporting the vehicles from Wellington to Timaru, Invercargill and Christchurch for all rounds. Returning to Wellington post-race at Ruapuna. Cost per car is just \$1750 for all rounds.

Information for Transport Package:

All cars are to be delivered by the competitors to Carr & Haslam C/- 269 Mark Avenue yard in Grenada Village, Wellington, on Saturday 20th OR Sunday 21st January, 2024. Cars will be delivered to the track on the afternoon of Thursday 25th. Security is on-site at the circuit for the duration of the weekend. Post race Sunday, all cars will be transported to secured storage until the week prior to Invercargill. Access to vehicles is available throughout this period should any competitor require any repairs or work undertaken between rounds.

Suggested flights to Timaru:

Flights into Timaru are twice daily from Wellington only.

- Departing: 09:30hrs (arr 10:50hrs)

OR

- 17:40hrs (arr 19:00hrs)

It is suggested to arrive on Thursday night to allow time for set-up at the circuit prior to Friday's testing / practice. Event schedule still TBC by the event organisers.

Flights from Timaru:

Flights from Timaru are twice daily to Wellington only. Given the timing, no flights will be possible on the Sunday after racing. Monday morning 06:50 is the suggested flight option.

- Departing: 06:50hrs (arr 08:05hrs)

OR

- 11:15hrs (arr 12:30hrs)

Teretonga / Invercargill:

The Invercargill round will provide 4 x races over the weekend, along with testing on the Friday.

Again, although possible to arrive Friday morning – it is suggested to arrive into Invercargill on the evening of Thursday 14th March.

Ruapuna / Christchurch:

The Ruapuna schedule is still TBC by organisers. It will allow for testing on the Friday.
