**Madama Butterfly** – the nickname for Cio-Cio-San, one of the main characters in Puccini's opera of the same name.

Harvest** summerland, BC  
hand harvested 4<sup>th</sup> Sept, 2021  
@ average 19 brix

**Winemaking** crush & press, no skin contact  
wild & organic yeast fermented for 30 days  
traditional method; secondary fermentation in bottle  
aged 11 months on lees before being disgorged  
3.1 PH, 7.0g/L TA, 12.5% ALC, 3g/L RS

**Winemaker's  
Tasting Notes** color: pale salmon  
nose: fresh strawberries, pink grapefruit, and brioche  
palate: finely textured with a soft, creamy mousse;  
pure, expressive fruit leads to a dry finish

**In other words** Fresh, crisp, and elegant, this traditional method sparkling rosé boasts pure aromas of red berries, citrus, and apple, with a hint of toast. It's beautifully balanced wine in a classic dry Brut style.

california sushi rolls with fresh crab  
whole roasted chicken with lemon and herbs  
soft, sheep milk cheeses with roasted nuts
