QB: Jalen Hurts, Kenny Pickett, CJ Stroud: Gotta love the start here with Jalen Hurts having Top 3 potential at the position. Still, no guy has gotten more buzz at the position this summer than Pickett who should yield a solid QB2 return. Overall Grade: A-

RB: Nick Chubb, Travis Etienne, Gus Edwards: After almost 20 years in the league, someone should let Greg know that helps to draft more than two RBs. In this context, "Gus" is short disGUSting as it pretty much sums up the depth he has at the position. Chubb is as steady as they get as far as RB1's go and Etienne has high upside as a RB2. What's good ends there as rostering only 3 RBs, one of which who doesn't start is more of a risk than having unprotected sex with a Kardashian sister right after NBA All Star Weekend. As long as there are no injuries or Bye weeks, he should be fine.

Overall Grade: B-

WR: Tee Higgins, DeAndre Hopkins, Michael Thomas, Jordan Addison, Jameson Williams, Robert Woods, Allen Robinson: While the name value tells one story, my got instinct tells another. Tee Higgins is in a contract year, and should yield positive results, however, It's hard to see him as anything better than a low-end WR1, considering he's not even WR1 on his own team.
