Introduction

History

Roots:

- Originated over 4,000 yrs ago with evidence leading towards ancient Egypt and India
- Medieval/ Renaissance Periods saw puppetry be used to dramatize biblical stories then later be used for satires and comedies during the 16th Century
- European Immigrants brought the art to America with traveling puppet shows during the 18th and 19th centuries.

Purpose:

- Evolved from ritualistic practices to entertainment and storytelling today
- Used originally to represent gods and deities

Puppetry

Marionettes:

 Operated from above using strings/ rods (pop. 17th century)

Hand Puppets:

 (glove puppets) operated by wearing them over your hand

Shadow Puppets:

 Operated by having flat figures held between a screen and light source (Pop. in China)

Bunraku Puppets:


 Known for their striking appearance (origin in Japan)

Modern:

- Puppet Animation (films/tv)
- Education as a powerful tool for storytelling

- Tape
- Googly Eyes or Beads
- Ribbon
- If puppet needs hair: cut up pom-pom or pipe cleaners
