Currency:

The official currency of Dubai is the United Arab Emirates Dirham (AED). Denoted as "[..." or "AED,"

While major credit cards are widely accepted, it's advisable to carry some cash, especially for smaller establishments and markets.

Weather:

Dubai experiences a desert climate, characterized by hot summers and mild winters. From November to March, temperatures range from around 15°C (59°F) to 25°C (77°F), making it the most pleasant time to visit. Summer, from June to September, can be extremely hot, with temperatures soaring above 40°C (104°F). Visitors should plan activities and outings accordingly, with indoor attractions and evening ventures recommended during the scorching summer months.

Dress Code:

While Dubai is modern, it's respectful to dress modestly in public areas. Beachwear is appropriate at beaches and pools.

Cultural Respect:

Respect local customs and traditions, particularly during religious events. Public displays of affection should be kept to a minimum.

Language:

Arabic is the official language, but English is widely spoken and understood.




