## **ASCA RALLY IS OPEN TO ALL BREEDS (Including Mixed Breeds)**

**Policies:** Bitches in Season will not be allowed to compete in this trial, either in rally or obedience. Upon verification of being in heat by a veterinarian or the trial committee, the entry fee will be refunded if wished.

**Location: Bear's Dog Shop, 7210 Worline RD. Bow Washington 98232**

Mapquest and GPS doesn't always get you here

From North:

I-5 to Exit 236-Bow-Hill Exit

Turn R(west) at stop sign

Go about a mile or two and turn Left on Ershig.

Go down the hill and over the railroad tracks

Turn R on Worline. Pass the Second Dairy on the left. Bears's Dog Shop is the brown building on the left.

From South:

I-5 North to exit 231- Chuchanut Drive/Hwy 11. Takes you to roundabout-Head North on Chuckanut Drive/Highway 11 (take the 3<sup>rd</sup> turn out of first roundabout; it will take you over the freeway. Then at next roundabout, get in R lane and turn R on Chuckanut Drive/Highway 11)

Go about 5 miles; turn R on Sunset.

Go to stop sign; turn R on Worline

Bear's Dog Shop is the first dairy on the R

From Anacortes or Whidbey Island

Highway 20- Turn L(east) on Farm to Market Road ( it is the road past the Farm House and goes to LaConner)

Follow the road for a awhile you will be in a treed area and then you drop down into the Skagit Flat; go about another mile and turn R on Sunset. ( You have gone too far if you get to Edison.)

Follow Sunset through a stop sign( you will cross Chuckanut Drive) go straight, still on Sunset.

When the road comes to a T at the stop sign- turn R onto Worline.

Third place on right big brown pole building.
