Trial Divisions: Post Advanced, Advanced, Open, Started, Novice Handler, Junior Handler, FEO. Trial Entry Limit: 50 run limit / Judge / day. Friday and Saturday maximum cattle 20 runs / trial, Sunday maximum cattle 40 runs / day.

Cattle 3-10 head, Ducks 5-10 head, Sheep 3-10 head.

Friday and Saturday: AM arena trials include Post Advanced Sheep. PM Arena Trials - no Post Advanced. Sunday AM: Post Advanced Cattle and Post Advanced Sheep.

Sunday PM: Arena trial Ducks, Cattle, Sheep - no Post Advanced Friday AM and Saturday AM: dogs may enter either Post Advanced or Advanced Sheep but not both. Friday, Saturday, and Sunday: dogs entered in AM Post Advanced may also enter in the PM Arena Trial.

For each day: High Score Advanced, High Score Open, High Score Started.

From Friday, Saturday, or Sunday Trials: High Score Post Advanced.

For the Weekend from Friday, Saturday, or Sunday Trials:

High Score Aussie, High Score Other Breed, High Score Sheep, High Score Ducks, High Score Cattle,

High Score Junior, High Score Junior Handler.

For the Weekend:

High Combined Sheep - all post advanced and arena sheep scores combined from Friday, Saturday, plus highest sheep score Sunday.

High Combined Cattle - all arena cattle scores combined from Friday, Saturday, plus highest cattle score Sunday.

High Combined Ducks - all arena scores combined from Friday, Saturday & Sunday. <u>Trophy Buckles</u>:

High Combined Other Breed - all post advanced and arena scores any division combined from Friday, Saturday, plus Sunday's duck score, highest cattle score, and highest sheep score.

High Combined WTCH Aussie - all post advanced and arena scores any division combined from Friday, Saturday, plus Sunday's duck score, highest cattle score, and highest sheep score.

High Combined Non-WTCH Aussie - for Aussies who have not earned the title of WTCH as of 4/22/21 - all post advanced and arena advanced scores combined from Friday, Saturday, plus Sunday's duck score, highest cattle score, and highest sheep score.

High Combined Open Aussie - all arena open scores combined from Friday, Saturday & Sunday.

High Combined Started Aussie - all arena started scores combined from Friday, Saturday & Sunday.
