Course E will be run with a left-hand chute and a take pen. Course H will be run counterclockwise with a take pen. Course B will be run clockwise with a gather.

Run order will be drawn prior to the trials; a wait list will be kept. Bitches in season will run in order. Substitution of owner's dog allowed if entry of another dog is pulled. Sheep will be Coop crosses, Cattle are beef cattle, Ducks are various cross breeds

AWARDS:

Ribbons: 1st thru 4th place.

Friday: High Scoring Post Advanced, High Scoring in Farm Dog Trial

Saturday & Sunday: High in Stockdog Trial Aussie for each trial, High in Stockdog Trial Other Breed for each trial, High Scoring Post Advanced for each AM Trial, High Scoring Cattle for each day, High Scoring Sheep for each day, High Scoring Ducks for each day, High Scoring Working Junior Handler & High Scoring Open Junior Handler for each trial.

Sunday: High Combined Aussie, High Combined Other Breed, *Most Promising Started Aussie (see description below), High Scoring Started Other Breed.

***Most Promising Started Aussie** is determined by the four highest combined qualifying scores from a minimum of two different classes of started stock (sheep/cattle/ducks). Ties are broken by the highest cattle score, if there are no qualifying cattle scores, then by the highest sheep score.

Class Order: **Handling:** 8-12 Novice and Open, 13-17 Novice and Open
Conformation: Non-regular: 2-4 mo, 4-6 mo Regular: 6-9 mo, 9-12 mo, 12-15 mo, 15-18 mo, Novice, American Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, BOB – classes divided by sex. Altered first, then Intact.

Pre-entry: Regular \$17, non-regular (including MVA Evaluation) \$10, **Day of:** Regular \$20, non-regular (including MVA Evaluation) \$12. All Junior Handling entries: \$5 (no extra fee for day of)

MVA Evaluation Judge: Margi Floyd, Judging will be after the conformation judging has been completed and will be in the conformation ring. Time is subject to change. ASC of WA ROM rules will be followed for computation of points (http://www.ascofwa.org/rom_rules.pdf) with the exception that Rally points can be used instead of Obedience points – whichever is higher (points to be scored the same as obedience). A QS is required in obedience or rally, stock and a passing score of 70% is required for the conformation evaluation.

No blow dryers in the arena, limited space available for set up in the arena, but other areas of the barn can be used. Limited electricity.

POLICIES: Only regular classes are eligible for High Score Awards. Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete in Obedience/Rally. Upon verification of being in heat by a veterinarian or the Obedience/Rally Committee, the entry fee will be refunded if wished. All Breeds may compete; however, they are required to have an ASCA Tracking number. This number may be applied for at the show. Owners/Handlers entering Novice Obedience/Rally who have titled a dog in any registry in Novice must enter Novice B. Any dog entering Novice or Open Obedience who has earned a CD or CDX in any registry must enter Novice B or

Open B, as appropriate. Any dog entering Advanced or Excellent Rally who has earned a RA or RE or an equivalent title in any other registry, must enter Novice B, Advanced or Excellent Rally, as appropriate.

From I5 take the Old Nisqually exit 116 and get on Old Pacific Hwy until it ends• Turn LEFT onto Hwy 510 in 1/2 mile turn RIGHT onto Meridian and follow it to the round about at Yelm Hwy• Continue on Meridian through a left turn and a right turn •When you see the 20mph left turn sign turn LEFT onto Evergreen Valley Rd •It is less than 1/2mile on your RIGHT.

Take exit 101 from I5• Go east (right) on Tumwater Blvd. Stay on it until it ends. • Turn left onto Henderson Blvd• At the stop light turn right onto Yelm Highway -- follow it east about 7 miles• At the 76 station turn RIGHT onto Meridian and follow it south through a left turn and a right turn • When you see the 20 mph left turn sign turn LEFT onto Evergreen Valley Rd• It is less than ½ mile on your RIGHT
