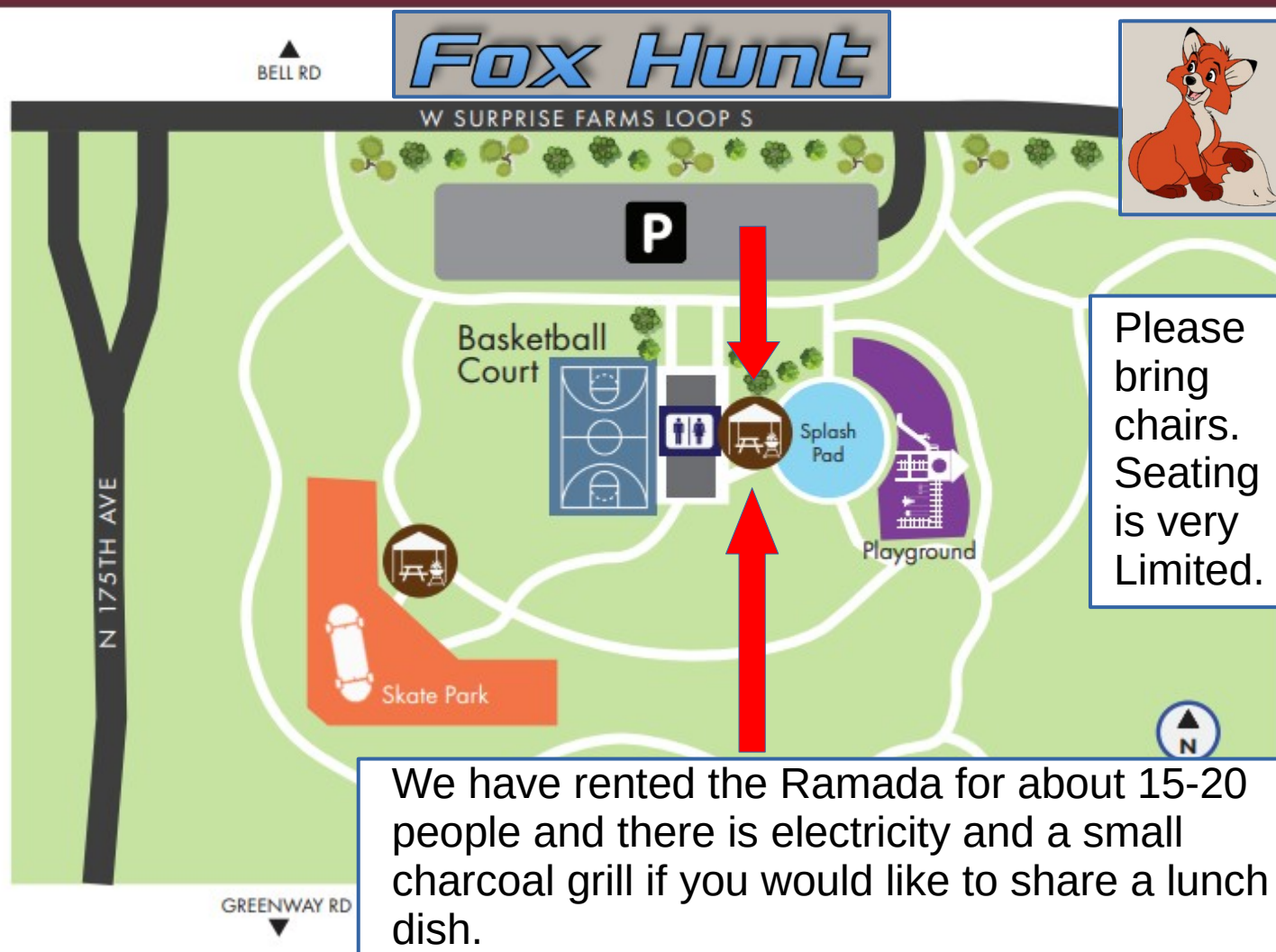
Bring your Yagi if you have one

Amateur Radio Direction Finding or ***Fox Hunting*** is similar to "Geocaching", or trying to find the hidden treasure. A radio which transmits a signal, is hidden in a tree or behind a post or inside a bush, or even in the trunk of a car.

Pairs of Fox Hunters will then travel around the park, using only the signal they receive on a hand-held radio, to decide where to look for the "Fox". Sometimes there is more than one hidden Fox, so that youngsters and those new to hunting are not competing with the more seasoned Hunter.

This is a fun Ham Radio activity that the entire family can enjoy. Come on out (bring your Yagi if you have one) and give it a try on March 9th!
