- Tornado
- Funnel Cloud
- Storm Damage (deaths, injuries, broken tree limbs, shingles off roofs, etc.)
- Flooding (streets, running washes, etc.)
- Low Visibility
  - less than 1 mile due to dust, sand, fog, etc. (not rain though)
- Rotating Wall Cloud
- Heavy Rainfall
  - measured ½ inch or more accumulation in 30 minutes or less
- Hail (diameter of largest stone any size)
- Snow (accumulating or not)
