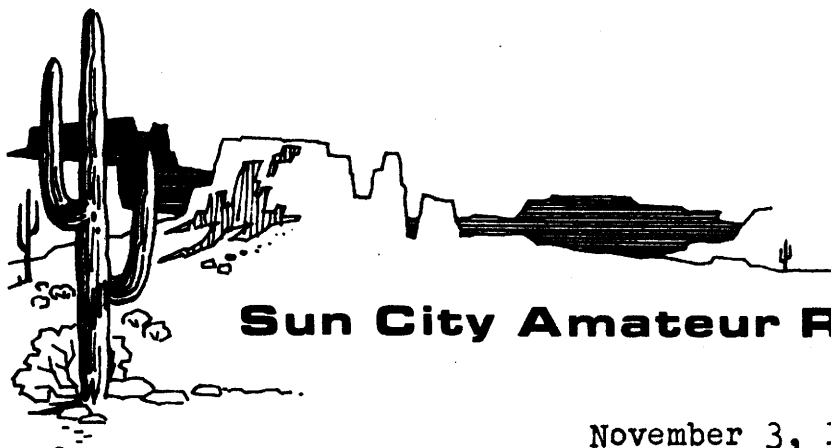

SUBJECT: 11/15/77 Meeting

To All Members:

On February 4, 1976 Guatemala was stricken with a violent earthquake, which measured 7.8 on the Richter Scale, occurring in the pre-dawn hours and lasting seven seconds.* Radio Amateurs carried their share of urgent communications to bring help to Guatemala.

KOOL Radio, Television in Phoenix, sent Bill Miller, Manager of their News Division, and Manny Garcia, News Photographer to Guatemala to bring back thru the video-tape route first hand information after the earthquake occurred, and later, another trip was made to show the progress of rebuilding.

Bill Miller, News Division Manager of KOOL will tell us of his experiences and show via video-tape and projection television, pictures of his trips.

Meeting, Tuesday November 15th, Fairway Recreation Center Club Room, 107th Ave. and Peoria Ave., Sun City, 7:30 PM.

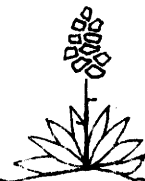
