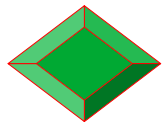
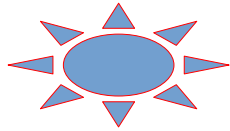
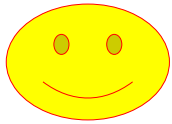


There are THREE pdf Flyers

Fox Hunt - BBQ Cook Off & Potluck Event!



**Come and participate in the fox hunt... stay for the
potluck and barbecue cook off!**

Do you like barbecue? Do you like potlucks? Do you like fox hunting?

The West Valley Amateur Radio Club is holding a fox hunt on November 20, 2021 at Sahuaro Ranch Park, 9802 N. 59th Ave., Glendale Arizona from 10 AM to 3 PM. Along with the fox hunt, we will also be holding a barbecue cook off and potluck lunch.

To participate in the fox hunt you will need a portable radio capable of receiving on the amateur radio 2 meter band (144 MHz - 148 MHz). The radio should have a signal meter to be effective. You will also need a directional antenna such as a small three element yagi. The "FOX" will be located in the park within walking distance of the starting point... no driving will be necessary.

Want to compete in the barbecue cook off? Bring your best barbecue dish to the park. Judges will be on hand to rate your entry. We will rate the best chicken, pork, and beef barbecue dish. Bring enough for at least three judges to taste, more if you want to provide your barbecue dish for the potluck.

Those that just wish to participate in the potluck... we ask that you bring a dish to pass.

TAKING ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

Personally, I don't really like freeway driving, so you may wish to follow my route from the SCW and SCG communities:

- 1) 303 south (or Litchfield) to Northern Pkwy.
- 2) Northern Pkwy east, past Loop 101 and Hwy 60 to N. 59th.
- 3) Take a Left and go north.
- 4) Pass Olive and take a Left onto W. Mountain View Road.
- 5) Parking lot is on your right.

Going Home:

- 1) From Mt View, take a right onto N. 59th.
- 2) Take a Right onto Olive.
- 3) Take a Right onto Hwy 60.
- 4) Follow Hwy 60 all the way home.

You could also take Hwy 60 to get there, but the Left turn at the Olive intersection might be confusing.

Alternate Route takes appx. 30 minutes
