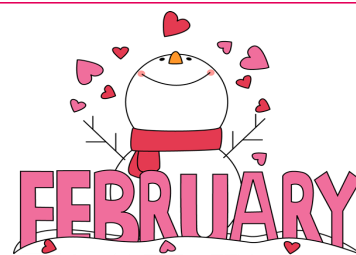




Breckinridge County Public Library News and Events Online Resources

	<p>Libby (Free E-Book Program) - We have access to Kentucky Libraries Unbound, which is an e-book, audiobook, video and music collection that is free for library patrons. Click the following image to access this service.</p>
