

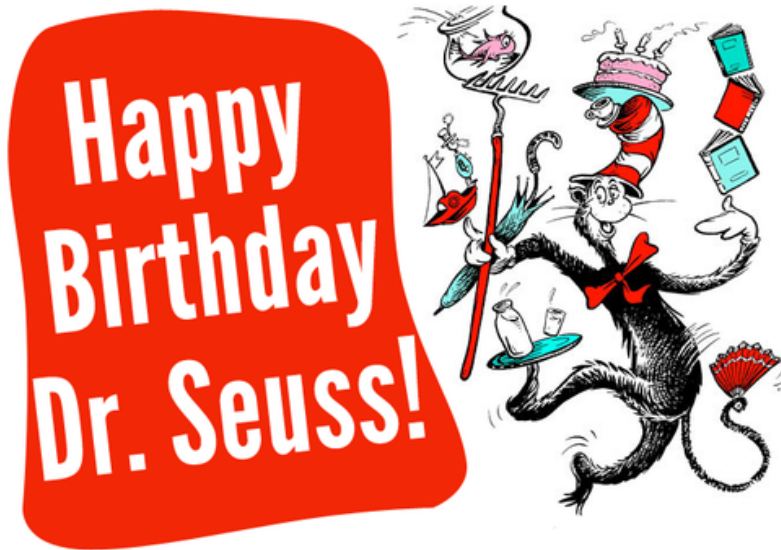


Breckinridge County Public Library News and Events Programs for February

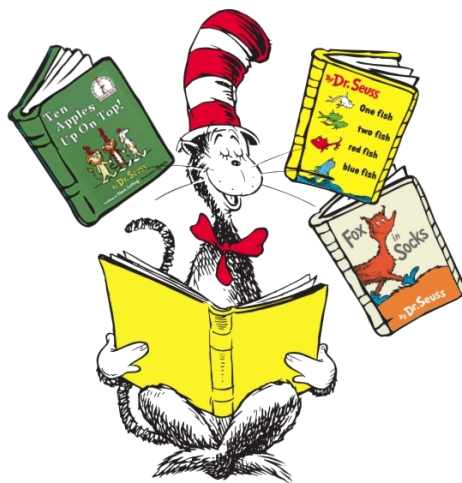
