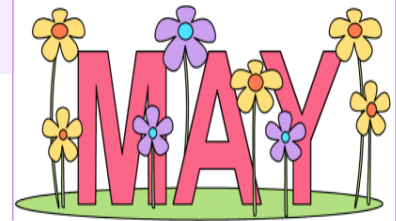
Summer Reading Excitement!

Our summer reading programs will start the first week of June, with a lot of fun and exciting programs taking place throughout the month. At the Hardinsburg Main Library we will have a program just for preschool aged children, an all ages program, and our special programmers. For the preschool program it will be on Tuesdays and Fridays from 10–11am. Each week will have a different theme along with a craft/activity. On Wednesdays from 1–2pm is our All Ages Program. There is a different theme and craft each week. For Week 1 (June 5) Astronaut Stress Ball, Week 2 (June 12) Galactic Goo (galaxy slime), Week 3 (June 19) Craft Roll Space Shuttles, and Week 4 (June 26) Watercolor Constellations.

We will also have some special programmers during summer reading this year. 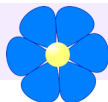
