Library Card Sign-Up Month

What can you do with your library card? With a library card you can check out books, audiobooks, movies (if 18 years or older), and use the computers.

- Books and audiobooks are checked out for 2 weeks and you can renew them if you need to.
- We have movie that can be checked out for 2 days and movies that can be checked out for 7 days.
- The late fines for books and audiobooks are \$0.05 per day/per book and the late fines for movies are \$2.00 per day/per movie.
- We have 10 public computers available for patrons to use.
- We have a copier and a printer available for patrons to use. It costs \$0.20 per page to print in black and white and \$1.00 per page to print in color.
- We also send and receive faxes for FREE!
