The Annual Meeting of the Steele County Agricultural Society was held November 3, 2022 at the Steele County Community Center. Steele County Free Fair Manager Scott Kozelka presented his annual report as did treasurer Tim Arlt.

The following incumbents were elected to each serve a 3-year term as Director: Bruce Busho, Gene Fisher, Josh Prokopec and Wayne Steele. Jim Linder did not seek re-election and was thanked for his years of service to the board with a standing ovation. Linder was first elected to the board in 1998 and served on the following

committees during his time on the board: Audit, Beer Garden, By-Laws, Carnival, Historian/ Museum, Hospitality, Landscape/Grounds, Memorials, Nominating, Salary Review, Personnel, Sanitation, Traffic Control, Signage and Utilities.
