
Steele County 🗸 Agricultural Society 🛖 **Annual Meeting**

★ SCFF Gives Back \$43.6K to Local Nonprofits ★



It has been no secret that the 2023 Steele County Free Fair was a great success. With income up, little to no incidents during the week and a new building on the horizon, the Fair Board has a lot to be proud of during the post-fair season.

But if you ask Fair Manager Scott Kozelka, there is one specific thing the group should truly be proud of.

During Thursday night's meeting of the Fair Board, Director Jim Abbe presented Annette Duncan, president of the United Way of Steele County, with a gift on behalf of the SCFF. To thank UWSC for all of the hard work done by its volunteers — especially in the grandstand — the SCFF donated a total of \$4,675 to the nonprofit's capital campaign.

That donation is one of many donations made by the SCFF since the end of the 2023 event. According to Kozelka, the fair has cut donation checks to more than 30 local nonprofits, ranging from vouth sports associations to churches and everything in between.

"If you are going to be proud of anything, this is what you should be proud of," Kozelka said.

In total, the fair donated \$43,621 to local nonprofits.
