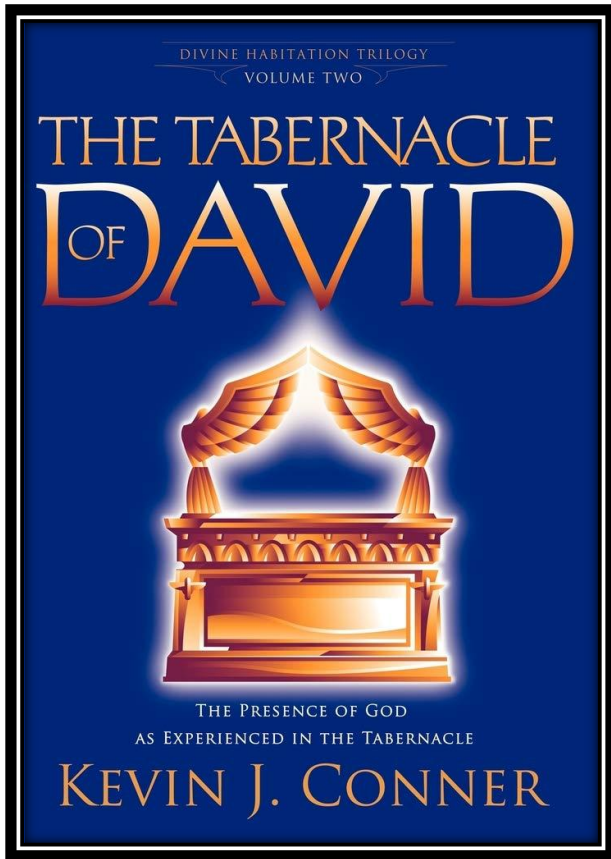
Description of Course:
