## **Description of Course:**

This class provides an overview and study of the Old Testament historical books, from Joshua through Esther. The course emphasizes the theological themes, key figures, and God's covenant purposes revealed through these books. By exploring the narratives, students will gain insight into how God worked through history to prepare the way for Christ and how these lessons apply to faith and life today.


