Description of Course:

This course explores the collection of New Testament letters known as the General Epistles: Hebrews, James, 1–2 Peter, 1–3 John, and Jude. Unlike Paul's letters, which were written to specific churches or individuals, these writings are addressed to broader audiences, offering timeless encouragement, exhortation, and instruction for believers across all generations.


Students will examine the historical background, authorship, and purpose of each letter, with attention to their central themes: faith and works (James), perseverance under suffering (1 Peter), warnings against false teachers (2 Peter and Jude), assurance of salvation and love (1–3 John), and the supremacy of Christ (Hebrews). Literary style, theological insights, and practical applications will all be emphasized.
