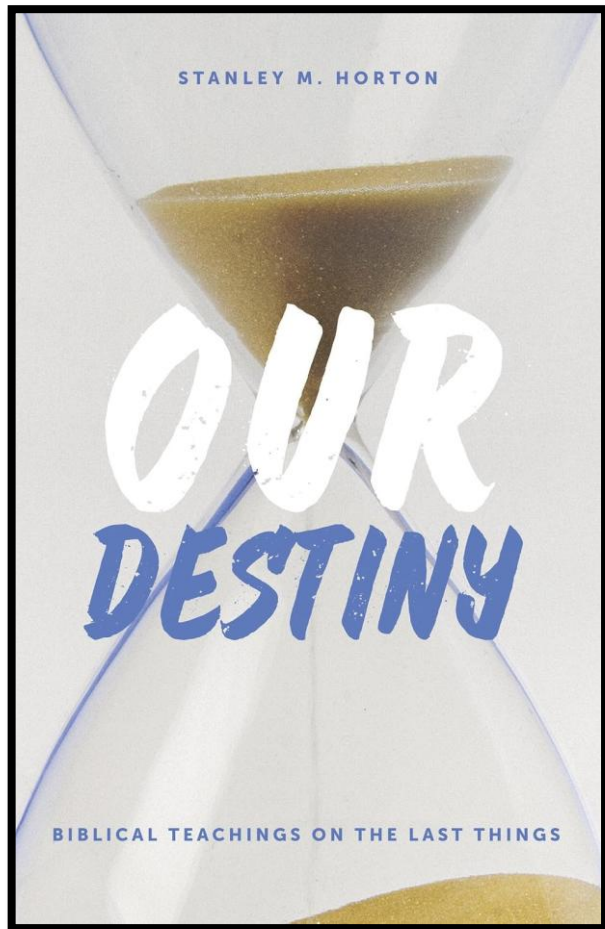

Description of Course:

This course provides an in-depth study of Biblical Eschatology, the theological discipline that examines the “last things” as revealed in Scripture. Students will explore God’s ultimate plan for humanity, the church, and creation, with a focus on the Second Coming of Christ, resurrection, final judgment, and the establishment of God’s eternal kingdom.

The course emphasizes both the prophetic and practical dimensions of eschatology, helping students understand the hope, warnings, and promises of Scripture. It examines eschatological themes across both the Old and New Testaments, tracing how God’s redemptive plan unfolds progressively and culminates in Christ.
