Description of Course:

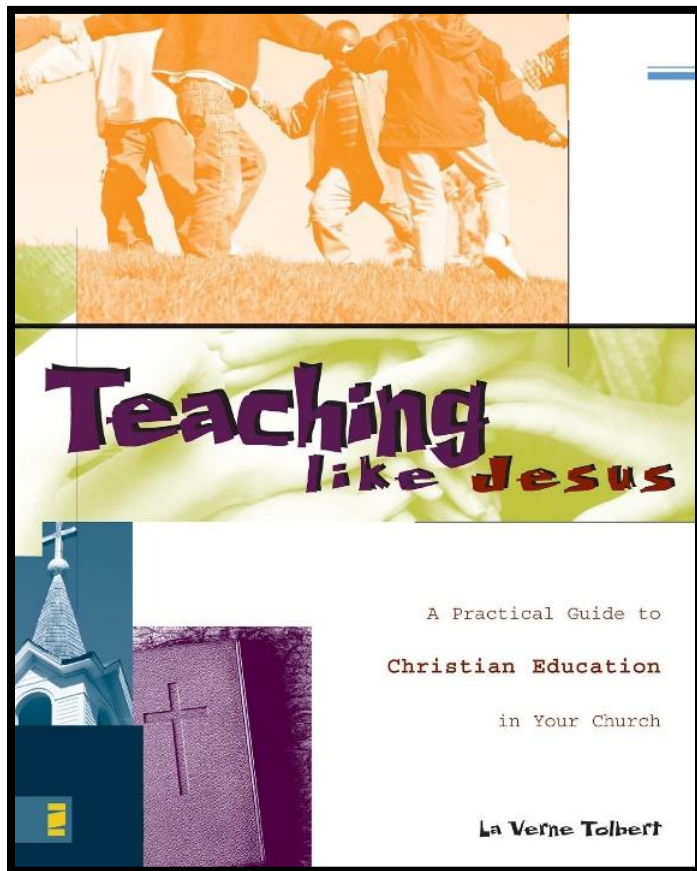
