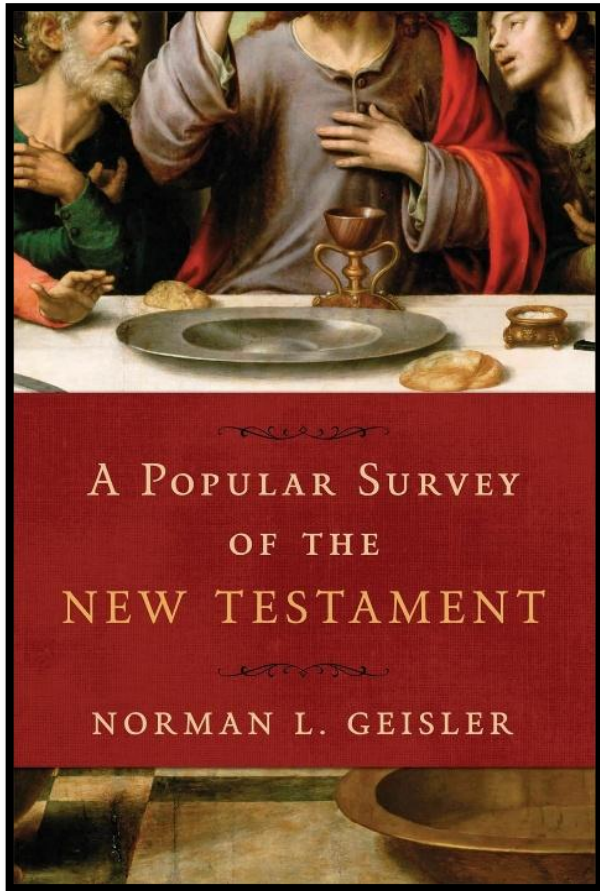

Description of Course:

This course provides an in-depth study of the four Gospels Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John as the foundational accounts of the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The course will highlight central themes such as the kingdom of God, discipleship, the identity of Christ, and the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy.
