<u>Confession</u> —Silently confessing your sins to the God who forgives
If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9
<u>Thanksgiving</u> —Thanking God for what He has done (This is when we thank God for answered prayers)
In everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:18
<u>Intercession</u> —Coming to God in prayer on behalf of others
For our First Responders- prays for a specific individual or in general
Scripture 1: May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with From 2 Corinthians 13:14
Scripture 2: Lord, may You be a shield around, may You be the One who lifts his/her head high. From Psalm 3:3
For our First Responder Agencies—pray for the Chief and individuals of each agency.
Scripture 1: Open's eyes and turn him from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God so that he may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in Jesus. From Acts 26:18
Scripture 2: LORD, when prays, may You answer him and encourage him by giving him the strength he needs. From Psalm 138:3
