- 3 Yard Line- 2 rounds in 3 seconds, two handed, drawn from the holster x1
- 3 Yard Line- 2 rounds in 2 seconds, two handed, from a ready position x2
- 7 Yard Line- 1 round in 3 seconds, two hands, from holster x5
- <u>7 Yard Line</u>- 1 round two hands, Emergency Reload, 1 round support hand in 15 seconds, from holster x1
- 7 Yard Line- 1 round in 3 seconds, support hand only, from ready position x5

<u>7 Yard Line</u>- 2 rounds to body (B) and 1 round to head (H) in 6 seconds, two handed, drawn from the holster x1

<u>15 Yard Line</u>- 3 rounds in 6 seconds, two handed, from a ready position, left side standing barricade

<u>15 Yard Line</u>- 3 round in 6 seconds, two handed, aimed in, left side kneeling barricade

<u>25 Yard Line</u>- 3 round in 10 seconds, two handed, drawn from holster while moving to right side barricade

25 Yard Line- 2 round in 5 seconds, two handed, aimed in, right side barricade

25 Yard Line- 1 round in 3 seconds, two handed, aimed in, right side barricade

Three Headshots Scored Above the Neckline with Corresponding Values of 5/2/0
