Visit Purpose: Investigate complaint.

Visit Location: Offices, Science Room 123 and Chemical Storage Room 124

Visit Summary: Complaint investigation commenced. Orders Issued. Accompanied by S. Tavakoli, MLITSD Hygiene Consultant. See detailed narrative.

**Detailed Narrative:**

Attended workplace on June 19, 2025 to investigate a complaint submitted to the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development. The complainant has made the following allegations:

The chemical storage room has no dedicated exhaust, either on the storage cabinets or within the room itself and there are concerns that any vapours that may be given off when the cabinets are opened, are a potential hazard to the workers within the room or other workers within the facility, when the vapours are removed from the room through the shared HVAC air handling system.

**INVESTIGATION ACTIVITIES:**

Discussed specifics of concerns and history of the area over the last several years.

Discussed 'best practices' vs. enforceable legislated requirements.

Recorded equipment information for the fume hood in use is room 123 and the acid and flammable storage cabinets in use in chemical storage room 124.

Conducted flow test on the fume hood to verify that it was operating adequately.

(ORDER ISSUED) During the inspection of the chemical storage room 124, it was observed that the mechanical ventilation within the room was inoperable and the air within the area was stagnant. It was indicated that the ventilation had not been working for a lengthy extended period of time. Workplace parties indicated that a work order had been initiated to have this repaired but no timeline had been established. A 'Plan' order is being issued to the employer to advise the Ministry of the date by which the ventilation system will be maintained.

(REQUIREMENT ISSUED) The employer shall provide the Ministry with a copy of the Section 5 Module of the Safety Procedures for Science Department documents. A copy of this document was given to the Ministry at the time of the visit.




