This inspector visited the above project on a reactive visit along with A. Juric (MLITSD) for a complaint received to the MLITSD contact centre.

Complaint:

Concerns for containment measures in place - no sealed-off work areas, no tarping, and no extra air filtration.

Project Description:

Lighting upgrade

Discussions and observations:

- Reviewed administration documentation (NOP, emergency procedures) (Order issued)
- No workers were observed working on active abatement
- Supervisor told this inspector that work only takes place during the weekends
- No contraventions were observed
- Supervisor told this inspector that active containment measures are in place, active air monitoring and vacuuming
- The internal responsibility system (I.R.S.)

Hygienist Comments - A. Juric, MLITSD Hygiene Consultant, CIH:

- The scope of asbestos abatement work being conducted by CLC Infrastructure workers was discussed during this visit. The work involves a Type 2 abatement of ceiling tiles in various parts of the school occurring over weekends in phases, and a planned Type 3 abatement of plaster ceilings at a later date. Initial work occurred over the September 5 weekend on the 3 floor. Measures and procedures that were in place for the abatement on the September 5 weekend were discussed/ reviewed. No abatement activities were occurring at the time of this visit.
