4. Payment Terms

The Company agrees to compensate the Contractor as follows:

6. Confidentiality & Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)

To protect the Company's sensitive information:

- 1. **Definition of Confidential Information:** Includes, but is not limited to, client lists, business plans, trade secrets, intellectual property, and financial records.
- 2. Contractor Obligations: The Contractor agrees to:
 - Not disclose or use the Company's confidential information for any purpose other than performing services under this Agreement.
 - Immediately return or destroy any Company materials upon request or upon termination of this Agreement.
- 3. **Survival of NDA:** This clause remains enforceable indefinitely, even after the termination of this Agreement.

7. Ownership of Intellectual Property (IP)						
 Work Product: Any work product, inventions, designs, trademarks, copyrights, or other creations (collectively, the "Work Product") produced during the course of this engagement will be the sole and exclusive property of the Company. Assignment of Rights: The Contractor agrees to assign any rights, title, or 						

- Assignment of Rights: The Contractor agrees to assign any rights, title, or
 interest in any Work Product to the Company.
- **Use of Work Product:** The Contractor shall not use the Work Product for any purpose other than the work defined in this Agreement without prior written consent from the Company.
- **Return of Materials:** Upon termination of this agreement, the Contractor agrees to return all Company materials, documents, and intellectual property.

8. Independent Contractor Status

The Contractor is retained as an independent contractor and is not an employee of the Company.

- 1. **Tax Responsibilities:** The Contractor is responsible for:
 - Paying all applicable taxes.
 - Maintaining their own records for tax reporting purposes.
- 2. **Authority:** The Contractor shall have no authority to:
 - Bind the Company to agreements.
 - Act as a representative of the Company in any capacity other than providing the agreed-upon services.

9. Record-Keeping Clause

 The Contractor shall maintain detailed records of all work performed under this Agreement for a minimum of [insert number] years and provide copies to the Company upon request."

10. Termination Clause

Either party may terminate this agreement with 30 days' written notice. In the
event of termination, the Contractor shall be compensated for work completed up

11. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes related to this Agreement shall be resolved through mediation or arbitration in the state of Pennsylvania, as mutually agreed upon by both parties.

- 1. **Costs:** The costs of mediation/arbitration shall be shared equally between both parties.
- 2. **Binding Decision:** The decision of the mediator/arbitrator shall be final and enforceable in a court of law.

12. Miscellaneous Provisions

- **Governing Law:** This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Pennsylvania.
- **Amendments:** Any amendments to this agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties.
- Fringe Benefits: Contractor understands that neither Contractor nor Contractor's employees or contract personnel are eligible to participate in any employee pension, health benefits, vacation pay, sick pay, or other fringe benefit plan of Client.

• **Unemployment Compensation:** Client shall make no state or federal unemployment compensation payments on behalf of Contractor or Contractor's employees or contract personnel. Contractor will not be entitled to these benefits in connection with work or Services performed under this Agreement.
