**I. Call to Order:** President Chet Atkins started the meeting at 6:34 p.m.

**II. Secretary's Report:** Audrey Erickson emailed the Secretary's report. Mike LaMont moved to approve the report, Bobbi Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**III. Treasurer's Report:**

- A. The treasurer's report was presented by Steve Miller. Damon Janssen moved to approve the report, Darragh Killilea-Wicks seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**IV. Committee Reports**

- A. Hospitality and Spirit (Wicks, Millers, Janssens, Thiels)
  - a. Damon Janssen explained the purpose and function of this committee, such as fan appreciation, tailgating, etc.
  - b. Recent events were handing out individually-wrapped cookies at the National Honor Society induction ceremony.
  - c. Hopefully the new AD will be more receptive and will have more of a vision of the fun that could be generated by a t-shirt cannon.
- B. Registration/Membership (Atkins, Bartells, Astrups)
  - a. 9th grade orientation/registration is set for August 11,12 and 16.

- C. Advertising (Breitbachs, LaMonts)
  - a. Kevin Breitbach explained the mission of the Advertising Committee, which is to keep revenue coming in through advertising on the sign and scoreboard.

#### **V. Old Business**

- B. Key Club water bottle survey results: 80/100: respondents (approximately) indicated an interest in a new water bottle. #### **VI. New Business:**

A. Track Project update: the School Board approved a track complex to be built on the campus of Fargo North. Construction will begin in the spring of 2022. Eventually there might be add-ons that the Booster Club and/or private donors can help fund.
