What is the Purpose Project Academy?

With the growing number of homeschoolers, those on waiting lists to get into and those transitioning out of ABA services as well as families wanting a different level of support, Purpose Project Academy is a program that aims to serve the “in-between” needs. Families will have access to high quality therapeutic education project-based curriculum used at The Hope Source, implemented within a trauma-responsive approach by highly trained educators and clinicians.

Who is Purpose Project Academy program for?

- K through 8th Graders with special learning needs
- Ages 6+ whose educational progress is impacted social, cognitive or behavioral struggles.
- Students (and parents) with educational trauma, anxiety, PDA, ADHD, etc.
- Special needs homeschoolers who need additional support or belonging

What Services are provided?

- Special Education Tutoring/Intervention
- Occupational Therapy
- Individual/Group Behavioral Therapy
- Individual/Group Mental Health Counseling
- Speech Therapy
- Individual/Group Recreational and Music Therapy
- Family Therapy/Parent Training
- Art Based Social Groups

What skills are being addressed?

- Math: computation, number sense, operations, measurement, etc.
- ELA: decoding, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, etc.
- OT: Sensory, Handwriting/Typing, Executive Functioning, etc.
- Behavioral: Social-emotional reciprocity, self-regulation, attentional control, flexible thinking, perspective taking, etc.
- Mental Health: confidence, self-esteem, healthy coping and habits, etc.
- Speech: Social Communication, apraxia, hyperlexia, dyslexia, etc.
- Family: Behavior Consultation, Parent-Child Relationship, Crisis Management, etc.
- Recreational & Music: leisure skills, adaptive sports, dance, instruments, genre exploration, etc.
- And More!



Who are the providers?

- Licensed Education or Special Education teachers trained in Orton Gillingham and other intervention strategies with support of Instructional Assistants and Student Teachers if applicable.
- Licensed Clinicians in OT, Speech, Mental Health and Behavior Analysis
- Certified Recreational and Music Therapies and/or gifted Registered Behavior Technicians in the fine arts or physical arts.

Fall 12 Weeks: HopeTank

Project Group focuses on invention, business, budgeting, marketing, etc. Ends with a pitch to the "sharks".

Winter 12 Weeks: HopeStudio

Project Group focuses on creation through fine arts, graphic design, stop motion, building, etc. Ends with a Art Gallery Expo.

Spring 12 Weeks: Hope500

Project Group focuses on all things speed! Transportation, force, movement, etc. Ends in pinewood derby race.

July Week: HopeCamp

A 4-day summer camp focuses on "survival skills", independent living and team building. Ends in a field day.

All project groups and tutoring intervention use our Thera-Science Labs to learn concepts within the scientific method.

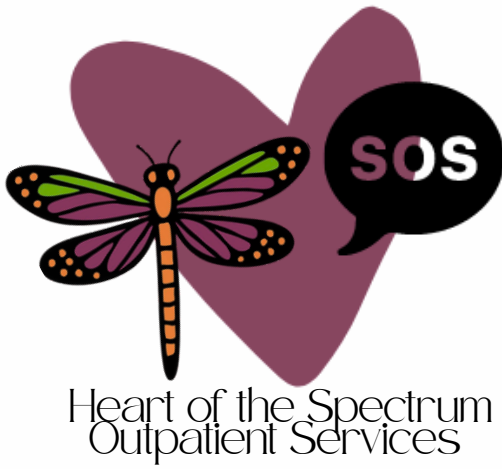


While most services are 1:1, students will be placed in cohorts based on several factors: biological age, developmental level, academic level and other factors to ensure their success.

Educational and Clinical Assessments must be completed before services can begin and for cohort placement.

Cohort B	Grades 3-5	2nd and 6 th when appropriate
Cohort C	Grades 6-8	9-12 th may be available in the future!
