## **Lesotho Gospel Outreaches**

## Morapamiseng Village; 08 – 10 February

This village is not far from the place I was born, very popular with witchcraft activities. We were able to do only one evening out of the three nights, because of the challenges we encountered. That one evening had a great impact on the villagers, with souls coming into the Kingdom.



# Ha-Sofonia Village; 15 - 18 February

This is a rural village rich with the Basotho history, just outside the capital city Maseru, not far from the Thaba-Bosiu, the castle of the Basotho nation founder. I was told by the host pastor that the house behind our gospel truck was build in 1864 by one of the sons of the founder of the Basotho nation King Moshoeshoe1, hence Chief Sofonia.
