Strategic Highlights

The year 2025 (1446-47 AH) brought both challenges and resilience to the people of Afghanistan and Pakistan. Afghanistan continued to face severe humanitarian pressures, including the return and reintegration of large numbers of deported refugees, persistent economic hardship, and food insecurity. Pakistan likewise confronted economic strains and the need to support vulnerable communities affected by poverty. Amid these circumstances, Afghanistan-Pakistan Women's Economic Empowerment (APWEE) remained steadfast in its mission to uplift disadvantaged women and their families.

Thanks to your generosity, APWEE provided emergency food assistance and hygiene kits to 65 deported Afghan women and their families, helping them meet their most basic needs during a difficult period of transition. We also renewed three STEM scholarships for talented young women living in poverty in Balochistan, Pakistan, enabling them to pursue higher education and prepare for careers that will strengthen their communities.

In 2025 (1446-47 AH), APWEE launched a new educational initiative to develop practical learning resources for our beneficiaries. These materials include themes such as Mothers as Teachers, Mothers as Managers, and Mothers as Changemakers, while also promoting women's health, mental well-being, growth mindset, and professionalism. Through this effort, we seek not only to provide immediate relief but also to foster the knowledge, confidence, and leadership that empower women to transform their families and societies.

PROJECT SUMMARY

In 2025 (1446-47 AH), APWEE provided emergency food assistance and hygiene kits to 65 deported Afghan women and their families, who are still struggling to meet basic needs, and renewed three STEM scholarships for female students living in poverty in Balochistan, Pakistan.



Additionally, APWEE issued a small business grant to a woman in Kabul, Afghanistan, who employs 15 women in her company, which produces medical clothes including doctor clothes, patient clothes, and surgical clothes, supplying sewing machines and related equipment.
