TO ENTER:

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE REGISTERED AND IN PLACE BY Sunday, September 22, 2024, 4 PM.

****All exhibitors **MUST** purchase EITHER a **Season Ticket or Membership Ticket** to enter. **Absolutely NO exceptions.** Season Tickets are \$45 each, or Membership Tickets are \$46 each. **Membership Tickets** may **ONLY** be purchased by **Brown County Adult Residents, age 18 and over**, and must be purchased at the Fair Board Office by 8 PM on September 17, 2024. All out of county exhibitors will need to purchase a **Season Ticket.**

REGISTRATION OPTIONS:

- 1) You may Register and purchase Season Tickets Sunday, September 22, 2024 at the Brown County Beekeepers Booth in the New Merchants Building between 12 PM and 2 PM when you drop off your entries. **All Gates will be open Sunday.**
- 2) You may turn in your completed Entry Form and purchase Tickets in person at the Fair Board Office prior to Sunday.
- 3) You may Mail in your completed Entry Form and purchase your Season Ticket, by sending a check or money order for \$45 per Season Ticket payable to: **BROWN COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY.** To receive your Entry Tags and Season Tickets by mail, please enclose a Business Size Self Addressed Stamped envelope bearing 2 First Class Stamps with your completed Entry Form and Check or Money Order, post marked on or before Sunday, September 29, 2024.

- 4) **Honey must remain on exhibit until Sunday, October 1, 2024 when it will be released from 9 AM until 1 PM.**

RULES:

- 1) The Judge's Decision is Final.
- 2) Care will be taken to prevent the loss, theft, or breakage of any article, but the Brown County Agricultural Society will NOT be responsible should this occur.
- 3) Each Exhibitor may only have ONE entry per class.
- 4) Extracted Honey should be shown in a standard 1 lb. Classic jar with honey level to the fill line.
- 5) Comb Honey should be shown in a square or round standard Comb container.
- 6) Chunk Honey should be shown in a standard 1 pint clear glass wide mouth canning jar with lid and trim ring.
- 7) Black Jar Honey must be shown in a standard 1 lb. Classic jar, filled to the fill line. Black Jar Honey will be judged solely on the taste of the entry.
- 8) Each Exhibitor will be given an Exhibitor Tag to put on their jars. There should be no Names, Identifying Labels, or Decorations on the jars other than the assigned Tag.
- 9) Ribbons and premiums (\$10.00 / \$5.0 will be awarded to all first and second place winners. **A Best of Show Trophy and Fifty Dollars** will be awarded to the Most Outstanding Entry.
- 10) Judging will begin 1 PM, Monday, September 23, 2024.
