SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. There will be no paging at the secretary's office but paging may be done at the old secretary's office on the north side of the center ring.
2. **Golf carts and AMT vehicles will only be used by the Fair Board members and those authorized by the Fair Board during the fair hours.** Concessionaires may use such vehicles before the hours of 10 AM and after 10 PM. **Handicapped vehicles are acceptable without board approval. This rule will be strictly enforced!**

No drones are to be flown on the fairgrounds during the fair unless permitted by the Brown County Agricultural Society.
