

Here is a comprehensive summary of the prophetic lineage beginning with **Abel**, tracing through the Antediluvian Patriarchs, the Post-Flood Patriarchs, the Classical Prophets, and ending with the Apocalyptic Seers preserved in both the King James Version and the Ethiopian Canon.

Epoch 1: The Antediluvian Prophets (From Adam to the Flood)

[ABEL] → [ENOSH] → [ENOKH] → [METHUSELAH] → [LAMECH] →
[NOAH]

- **Abel:** The first martyred prophet (**Luke 11:50–51**). His blood sacrifice of an unblemished lamb prophesied the necessity of innocent blood to cover human sin, directly prefiguring the sacrifice of Christ (**Hebrews 12:24**).
- **Seth:** Son of Adam appointed in place of Abel. According to the *Book of Jubilees*, Seth preserved the sacred spiritual tradition and priesthood handed down from Adam.
- **Enosh (Enos):** Son of Seth. Under his generation, men began to "*call upon the name of the LORD*" (**Genesis 4:26**), establishing formal corporate prayer and worship on earth.
- **Enoch (Henok):** The "Seventh from Adam." A major apocalyptic prophet who walked with God and was translated without seeing death (**Genesis 5:24**). Author of the *Book of Enoch*, he prophesied the judgment of the Fallen Angels (Watchers) and the end-time return of the *Son of Man* with ten thousand saints (**Jude 14–15**).
- **Methuselah:** Son of Enoch and the longest-lived human (969 years). He served as the prophetic custodian of Enoch's books, passing the antediluvian revelations to Lamech and Noah.
- **Lamech:** Father of Noah. Exercised prophetic utterance at the birth of his son, foretelling that Noah would bring comfort from the heavy curse placed on the ground (**Genesis 5:29**).
- **Noah:** Called a "*preacher [prophet] of righteousness*" (**2 Peter 2:5**). He received the divine blueprint for the Ark, warned the ancient world of coming judgment, and established the Rainbow Covenant (*Jubilees 6*).

Epoch 2: The Post-Flood & Patriarchal Prophets

- **Shem:** Son of Noah who preserved the sacred scrolls on the Ark. In Ethiopian and Hebraic tradition, he is linked to the righteous priesthood that carried the line of the promise down to Abraham.
- **Eber (Heber):** Great-grandson of Shem and ancestor of the Hebrews. Prophesied the spiritual division of the earth during the days of his son Peleg (**Genesis 10:25**).
- **Melchizedek:** King of Salem and High Priest of the Most High God (**Genesis 14:18**). Operating outside the Levitical line, his eternal priesthood foreshadowed the high priestly ministry of Jesus Christ (**Hebrews 7**).
- **Abraham:** Explicitly named a prophet in **Genesis 20:7**. He received the unconditional Abrahamic Covenant, witnessed the destruction of Sodom, and prophetically foresaw the day of the Messiah (**John 8:56**).
- **Isaac:** Received the covenant promises from Abraham. His willing submission on Mount Moriah (*Genesis 22*) served as a prophetic blueprint for the crucifixion of the Son.

- **Jacob (Israel):** Received visions of the Heavenly Ladder (**Genesis 28**). On his deathbed, he uttered patriarchal prophecies over his 12 sons (**Genesis 49**), foretelling that the Messiah (*Shiloh*) would come from the tribe of Judah.
- **The 12 Patriarchs (Sons of Jacob):** As recorded in the *Testaments of the Twelve Patriarchs*, each son gave deathbed prophecies detailing the dual line of the Messiah (King from Judah, Priest from Levi) and the future apostle to the Gentiles (Paul from Benjamin).
- **Joseph:** A prophet of dreams and interpretations (**Genesis 37, 40–41**). His rejection by his brothers, exaltation in Egypt, and salvation of the known world served as a complete living type of Jesus Christ.

Epoch 3: The Mosaic & Historical Prophets

- **Moses:** The foundational prophet with whom God spoke "*face to face*" (**Deuteronomy 34:10**). He delivered Israel from Egypt, mediated the Mosaic Covenant at Sinai, wrote the Torah (and *Jubilees*), and prophesied the coming of the Ultimate Prophet (**Deuteronomy 18:15**).
- **Aaron & Miriam:** Aaron served as Moses' spokesman and first High Priest; Miriam is identified as the first female prophetess (*Nebi'ah*) in Israel (**Exodus 15:20**).
- **Joshua:** Successor to Moses who led Israel into Canaan. He operated with prophetic authority, commanding the sun to stand still (**Joshua 10**).
- **Deborah:** Prophetess and judge who led Israel to victory over Canaanite forces (**Judges 4–5**).
- **Samuel:** The transitional prophet who founded the "School of the Prophets," anointed Israel's first kings (Saul and David), and restored the voice of God in the land (**1 Samuel 3**).
- **David:** King and Prophet (**Acts 2:30**). Authored the Psalms, which contain dozens of explicit prophecies regarding Christ's trial, crucifixion, resurrection, and eternal throne.
- **Elijah:** The fiery prophet of Mount Carmel who confronted Baal worship, did not taste physical death, and was taken to heaven in a chariot of fire (**2 Kings 2**). Promised to return before the Great Day of the Lord (**Malachi 4:5**).
- **Elisha:** Successor to Elijah who received a double portion of the prophetic spirit, performing twice as many recorded miracles (**2 Kings 2–13**).

Epoch 4: The Classical Major & Minor Prophets

The Major Prophets

- **Isaiah:** Known as the "Evangelical Prophet." He foretold the Virgin Birth (**Isa 7:14**), the divine titles of the Son (**Isa 9:6**), and the detailed Suffering Servant (**Isa 53**).
- **Jeremiah:** The "Weeping Prophet." He foretold the 70-year Babylonian captivity and prophesied the **New Covenant** written on the human heart (**Jer 31:31–34**).
- **Ezekiel:** A priest-prophet who saw the throne-chariot of God (*Merkavah*), the Valley of Dry Bones (**Ezek 37**), and the future Millennial Temple.
- **Daniel:** The apocalyptic statesman who prophesied the rise and fall of four world empires, the exact timeline of the Messiah's death (**Dan 9**), and the coming of the *Son of Man* on the clouds (**Dan 7**).

The Minor Prophets

- **Hosea** (Unconditional love through his marriage), **Joel** (Outpouring of the Holy Spirit), **Amos** (Social justice & judgment), **Obadiah** (Doom of Edom), **Jonah** (Sign of 3 days in the whale / Christ's resurrection), **Micah** (Birth of Messiah in Bethlehem), **Nahum** (Fall of Nineveh), **Habakkuk** (The just shall live by faith), **Zephaniah** (The Day of the Lord), **Haggai** (Glory of the Second Temple), **Zechariah** (Messiah riding on a donkey; pierced for us), **Malachi** (The coming of Elijah and the Sun of Righteousness).

Epoch 5: The Apocalyptic Seers (Preserved in the Ethiopian Canon)

[EZRA / 4 EZRA] → [BARUCH / 4 BARUCH] → [ASAPH] → [JOHN THE BAPTIST]

- **Ezra (2 Esdras / 4 Ezra)**: The scribe-prophet who received 7 apocalyptic visions after Jerusalem's fall, visioned the Messiah as a Lion destroying the Eagle Empire, and supernaturally restored the 94 lost books of scripture (**2 Esdras 14**).
- **Baruch & Abimelech (4 Baruch / Paralipomena of Jeremiah)**: Scribe of Jeremiah who recorded the destruction of Jerusalem, the hiding of the sanctuary vessels, and the miraculous 66-year sleep of Abimelech under a fig tree.
- **Asaph & The Sons of Korah**: Levitical temple seers who wrote prophetic psalms regarding divine judgment and the heavenly assemblies (**Psalms 73, 82**).
- **John the Baptist**: The final prophet of the Old Covenant order. Declared by Jesus to be "*more than a prophet*" (**Matthew 11:9**), he fulfilled the prophecy of Elijah by preparing the way for the Messiah.
