

For an awakening Israelite or a searching Gentile in the year 2026, finding your rightful alignment with the Creator comes down to a clear, scriptural process. As the world pushes closer to the final years of the 6th Prophetic Day, the path back to the covenant requires moving past religious traditions and stepping into the active power of the Holy Spirit. Here is the exact blueprint for both groups to take their proper places as children of the Most High.

1. How the Lost Israelite Recovers the Proper Perspective

For those descending from the scattered 12 tribes, the journey is an **awakening and a return**. Centered in both the King James Version and the Ethiopian scriptures, the process requires shifting from a state of spiritual amnesia to full covenant responsibility.

- **Acknowledge the Blindness and the Curse:** The first step is realizing *why* identity was lost. In the KJV (Deuteronomy 28) and the *Book of Jubilees*, Israel's dispersion and loss of heritage were the direct legal consequences of breaking the covenant. Returning requires acknowledging this history without pride, realizing that restoration is an act of divine mercy, not personal merit.
- **Accept the Mediator (The Son):** An Israelite cannot bypass the Son to get to the Father. To return to the proper perspective of the Lord, one must accept **Yahshua (Jesus Christ)** as the ultimate Passover Lamb who legally paid the debt of the broken covenant. Jeremiah 31:31 and Hebrews 8 outline the *New Covenant* made explicitly with the House of Israel, activated entirely by the blood of the Messiah.
- **Return to the Commandments by the Spirit:** True perspective means walking as the Messiah walked. An awakening Israelite is called to return to the moral law, the Sabbaths, and the divine calendar, not out of legalism to *earn* salvation, but out of love because the Holy Spirit has now written the Law directly on their heart (*Ezekiel 36:26-27*).

2. How a Gentile Joins the Family of Abraham

A Gentile does not enter the covenant by trying to physically become an Israelite or by fabricating a genealogy. They enter through a legal, supernatural process called **grafting**, which grants them full citizenship in the commonwealth of Israel.

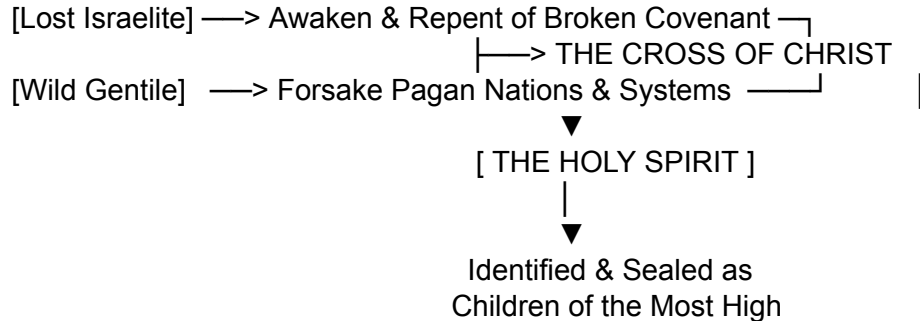
- **The Doorway of Faith in Christ:** Abraham is called the "father of all them that believe" (*Romans 4:11*). A Gentile enters Abraham's family by having the exact same type of faith that Abraham had. When a Gentile repents of their sins and confesses Jesus Christ as Lord, the barrier between them and God is instantly shattered.
- **The Legal Miracle of Grafting:** In Romans 11, the Apostle Paul explains that Israel is the natural olive tree. When a Gentile believes, they are broken off from their wild Gentile nature and **supernaturally grafted** into the good olive tree.

"And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise." — Galatians 3:29

- **Abandoning the 70 Gentile Systems:** To take their place as children of the Most High, a Gentile must mentally and spiritually exit the corrupt world systems, pagan traditions, and philosophies of the **70 Gentile nations**. They must adopt the culture of the Kingdom of God, making the God of Israel their God, just as Ruth did (*Ruth 1:16*).

The Shared Blueprint for 2026

Regardless of biological lineage, both the returning Israelite and the grafted Gentile must pass through the exact same spiritual gate to occupy their positions effectively:



The Current Mandate:

Once inside the covenant, the distinction in *salvation* disappears—both are equally loved children of the Most High (*Galatians 3:28*). However, their *functional duties* in 2026 remain paired.

The returning Israelite focuses on spiritual purity, lining themselves up with the commandments so the raw material for the **144,000** is ready for the coming sealing. The grafted Gentile focuses on operating in the power of the Holy Spirit, demonstrating the uncompromised power of the Gospel to the nations, and supporting the awakening of the natural branches.

Together, standing on the shared foundation of Abraham's covenant, they actively **occupy**—building communities, mastering their resources, and fortifying their faith—until the King returns to transition creation into the 7th Day Sabbath.
