### **Turning 65 Medicare Checklist**

6 months before your 65th birthday:

- Learn the basics of Medicare (Parts A, B, C, and D)
- If still working, check with your HR or benefits team
- Talk to your spouse about your options

3 months before turning 65:

- Enroll in Medicare Parts A and B (unless delaying Part B)
- Compare local plans (Medicare Advantage vs. Supplement)
- Review your prescriptions and doctors

1 month before your Birthday Month & Beyond:

- Finalize your coverage
- Start using your benefits
- Schedule a yearly wellness visit

## Medicare Advantage vs. Medigap (Supplement) Plans

**Quick Comparison:** 

Medicare Advantage (Part C):

- Usually lower premiums
- Use plan network of doctors
- Often includes dental, vision, hearing
- Copays/coinsurance apply
- Best for budget-focused, in-network care

- Higher premiums, but more predictable costs
- See any doctor who accepts Medicare
- Does not include extras like dental
- Covers most costs Medicare doesn't
- Best for frequent travelers or snowbirds

#### **Know Your Medicare Deadlines**

Initial Enrollment Period (IEP):

Starts 3 months before your 65th birthday and ends 3 months after.

Still working at 65?

You may be able to delay Part B and avoid late penalties. Ask us about it!

Annual Enrollment (Oct 15 - Dec 7):

For changing plans if you're already enrolled in Medicare.

## What to Ask Before Picking a Plan

- 1. Do I want to keep my current doctors?
- 2. What prescriptions do I take-and how are they covered?
- 3. How often do I travel?
- 4. Do I need dental or vision coverage?
- 5. What's my monthly budget for premiums?
