Bruce went out for public stud this year and was bred to 3 bitches and produced 4 litters , yes you read that right .




A lilac tri from the last litter on the right

On the left 10 pups Performance staff x Bruce lots of chocolates and tri coloured dogs all looked like heavy built staffs




## A catch up on my Foundation Bitch Quinny
